





#### Q. & A. I was born Catholic but...

# Q: I received First Communion and Confirmation when I was younger but I don't really remember much of what was taught and want to know more.

A: As adults we should always be seeking to learn more about our faith. We regularly have programs or events for adults at St. Thomas More. #### Q: We got married civilly but not in Church. Can we still do that?

A: If this is a first marriage for both of you then the answer is YES! No matter how long you have been married civilly. This is called marriage validation. It's a very simple process that starts with meeting with a priest. It does not require a large church marriage. This link will provide more details. If either of you have a previous marriage your process will require more details that the priest can help you navigate. <a href="stthomasmorechurch.org/marriage">stthomasmorechurch.org/marriage</a> The benefit of having your marriage validated is that you will then be able to receive Eucharist.

# Q: I got divorced. Am I still able to receive the sacraments of Eucharist and Confession?

**A:** If you were married in the Catholic Church and divorced and are currently not in a new marriage or new relationship then you are able to receive the sacraments. You should first make a good confession before receiving Eucharist. Remember Confession is a sacrament of healing and has powerful graces waiting for us.

# Q: I have children who are not babies who have not been Baptized. Is it too late?

Your gift will help sustain and grow diocesan ministries that form and support our future priests, affirm and teach our youth, assist the poor and the marginalized – and build our Church for the future.





#### **Christ is Anything but Ordinary**

We're about to dive headlong into week two of Ordinary Time, and we need to admit, after the hustle and bustle of the holidays, things are indeed looking more ... ordinary, at least in our spiritual lives. The transcendent highs of the Christmas season are flatlining a bit and the vivid imagery of the Nativity scene has faded. The solemn anticipation of the Advent season is by now a distant memory. Are you bored yet? Here's a secret: I think that Ordinary Time can actually be quite extraordinary, if we're really living out our baptismal call. In today's Gospel, Jesus point-blank asks Andrew, who is following him after hearing John the Baptist's testimony: "What are you looking for?" He's asking us the same question. What are you looking for? Why are you following me? Is it for the Christmas cookies and the Advent carols? Is it for the King's Cake on the Epiphany? Is it for the feeling we get on Christmas when we just know God has done a wondrous thing? None of those things are bad, but they are not what Andrew was looking for, and they were not what Christ promised him when he said, "Come, and you will see." Andrew was looking for the Messigh — the One who makes even Ordinary Time extraordinary. The One who can sanctify the longest and dullest of to-do lists, on the longest and dullest of days. The One whose peace can reign in our homes on January 25, not just December 25.

Remember what you are looking for. Come, and you will see.




