

Be Reconciled

On **Wednesday**, **March 20th** every church in the Rockford Diocese will be hosting Be Reconciled Day. St. Thomas More will have priests here to hear Confessions from **9:00am - 8:00pm**.

In preparation for your Confession, you should do the following:

- Set aside some time, find a quiet place, and ask God to be with you in your preparation.
- Ask God to reveal to you all that you need to share during confession.
- Find an examination of conscience. You can find one on our website stthomasmorechurch.org/reconciliation.
- If it makes you feel more comfortable you can write your sins down and bring that paper with you to Confession.

Upon arriving at Confession:

- Make the sign of the cross.
- Say, "Bless me Father for I have sinned, it has been ____ (time frame) since my last confession."
- Begin to tell him your sins. When you are finished let him know by saying "I am sorry for these sins and any sins I cannot remember at this time."
- Then listen to Father and any advice he may want to share and also for the penance he will assign to you.
- Pray the Act of Contrition (a copy of this prayer is in our Confessionals)



• Do the penance given to you.

Location of Blessed Sacrament

Q: Why do parishes have the Blessed Sacrament in a separate room?

A: While many Catholics of a certain age have memories of the Blessed Sacrament being housed in the tabernacle on the high altar of the church, many parishes in the decades since the Second Vatican Council have chosen to build a separate space - a reservation chapel - where the Blessed Sacrament is kept. of parish life. The practice of reserving the Eucharist in a separate space - or in a dignified location away from the altar where Mass is celebrated - is that it emphasizes the importance of the liturgy itself, which is the "source and summit" of the life of the Church.

The important thing is that as communities question where to place the tabernacle, they listen to the voice of the Church, explore the ancient and varied liturgical tradition of the Church, consider the needs and life of the community, and also take into account the architecture and limits of the spaces they might already have. ©LPi



Next Sunday is Palm Sunday

Question:

Where do Palm Sunday palms come from and where should they go?

Answer:

The Palm Sunday celebration has ancient origins. Beginning the liturgy "outside" the church, we symbolically reenact Christ's entry into Jerusalem. The crowds in ancient Israel waved palm branches – a symbol of royalty – to welcome Jesus. These days, obtaining palms takes a lot of planning and coordination, as hundreds of thousands of churches worldwide need them on the same day! Many in the United States order palms from Florida, California, Texas, or Central America. Many companies stress the sustainability of their production and the just wages paid to their workers.

The palms used on Palm Sunday are blessed at Mass. This means they shouldn't end up in the trash! Many people weave palms into crosses or families display them in their homes. If you do not plan on displaying your palms throughout the year, they should be burned, buried, or left at the church. In the final case, the palms are burned to provide the ashes for next year's Ash Wednesday service. ©LPi


