

Family Connection

Gospel Reading Luke 9:28b-36

Jesus is transfigured In today's Gospel, the voice from heaven speaks to the disciples saying, "Listen to him." The Transfiguration was a focused moment for the disciples when they heard God speaking to them and experienced Jesus in glory. They most certainly left this focused moment with a new appreciation for the importance of Jesus' words even if they did not yet understand everything that he had taught them. During Lent, we are invited to consider our attentiveness to Jesus and to one another. In the pace and noise that often characterizes family life, how well do we listen to one another? What opportunities do we have for quiet prayer?

As you gather as a family, count the number of pieces of equipment in your home that produce sound: televisions, radios, CD players, computers, video games, etc. Observe if sometimes more than one piece of equipment is playing simultaneously and how this might affect communication. Discuss the question: What is it like to try to talk with one another when this equipment is on?

Read aloud today's Gospel, Luke 9:28-36. Consider whether the noise and pace of your family life allows family members opportunities for quiet prayer. During Lent, it may be appropriate for your family to choose a time for quiet in the household by turning off televisions, radios, and CD players. Consider whether your family would like to establish such a time during this Season of Lent and suggest that it might allow you the opportunity to listen more attentively to one another and to find time for quiet prayer. Spend a few such moments as a family, asking God to help you listen.





Everything we know about Jesus indicates that he was concerned with only one thing: to do the will of his Father. Nothing in the Gospels is as impressive as Jesus' singleminded obedience to his Father. From his first recorded words in the Temple, "Did you not know that I must be busy with my Father's affairs?" (Luke 2:49), to his last words on the cross, "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit" (Luke 23:46), Jesus' only concern was to do the will of his Father. He says, "The Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees the Father doing" (John 5:19). . . . Jesus is the obedient one. The center of his life is this obedient relationship with the Father. This may be hard for us to understand because the word obedience has so many negative connotations in our society. It makes us think of authority figures who impose their wills against our desires. It makes us remember unhappy childhood events or hard tasks performed under threats of punishment. But none of this applies to Jesus' obedience. His obedience means a total, fearless listening to his loving Father. Between the Father and the Son there is only love.

CFF Registration Begins SOON! By Debbie Chalik

CFF Registration is about to begin! Formal registration will start on March 25. Here are details:

We will offer on-line registration and payment of fees. All students will be required to submit a baptismal certificate and pay all fees before they will be placed in a class.

For families who wish to register in person, we recommend scheduling an appointment since our office hours vary after classes end. We are available for in-office registration Monday -Wednesday from 10 am until 2 pm.

We have adjusted our fee schedule a bit and here is why:

- Our hope is that families will choose to enroll children *each year from 1st grade through Confirmation*. (Kindergarten is optional.) Each year builds on the last, consistent attendance is important.
- The fee chart below shows that children who are attending CFF in 3rd, 4th and 5th grade will pay no fees if they have received Eucharist and register by the deadline of June 30.
- Students who attend CFF in StartUp and TakeOff classes to prepare for First Eucharist will pay an increased fee. (Please note: to receive Eucharist in 2nd grade, students must attend 1st grade.)
- All other grades will be charged the same fees as last year. Catechist, assistant catechists, and support staff do not pay fees. The lead catechist in the classroom can receive payment for each class taught. See CFF staff to learn more about this opportunity.
- Tuition assistance will be offered until June 30. After that
 date, no assistance will be available. Parents will be able to
 help with the program and have fees waived if positions
 are available.






