

Parenting with Family Faith

When my son was 6 years old and ready to start kindergarten, he stomped his little foot and told me he hated me. (I have no idea what I did, but it must have been bad). I was shocked to the core. First, hate wasn't an everyday word used in our house. Second, I was his mom. What happened to the little boy who wouldn't let me leave the room? Luckily, he has since reconsidered his feelings.

I decided I needed some outside help. I had a neighbor friend with a son who was 8. She had parenting 'experience.' She told me I didn't need to worry. After all, my son was 6 years old. All 6 year olds are mad at their moms because they need them, which is irritating since they are trying so hard to grow up. Then my friend gave me a book. I am still not entirely sure her advice was true, but somehow it made sense and I felt better. Parenting was not for the faint of heart.

One of the most important jobs we have as parents is to guide our children in faith. I am sure you know that the primary responsibility falls to the parents. As a family, you have your own faith stories and your own faith traditions. When your child was baptized, you were given the responsibility to nurture your child in the ways of faith. With this huge responsibility, it is good to seek help from family, friends, and especially church.

At Sacred Heart, we are here to help you. In CFF, some of our students are attending public schools, others are learning from home. To help, we have put together a page of resources on our website to help you navigate the current choppy waters. These resources can help you make sure that faith is in your home. 
The Third Option


Inclement Weather

St. Vincent's Corner

HAVE YOU SEEN THESE PEOPLE.....

Today we want to focus on several excerpts of a song about two homeless people. Ralph McTell wrote the song, "The Streets of London", in 1969. While it was written about the homeless in London, it could have easily been about homeless people anywhere in the world.

The Streets of London

"Have you seen the old man in the closed down market, picking up the papers with his worn out shoes. In his eyes you see no pride and hanging loosely by his side, yesterday's papers, telling yesterday's news/

And in the all night cafe, at a quarter past eleven, the same old man sitting there on his own. Looking at the world over the rim of his teacup, each tea lasts an hour then he wanders home alone/

Have you seen the old man outside the seaman's mission, memory fading with the medals that he wears. /And in the winter city, the rain cries a little pity, for one more forgotten hero, and a world that doesn't care/

Have you seen the old dear who walks the streets of London, dirt in her hair and her clothes in rags. She's no time for talking, she just keeps right on walking. Carrying her home, in two carrier bags/"

The song ends in the refrain as follows, "So how can you tell me, you're lonely, and say for you that the sun don't shine. Let me take you by the hand and lead you through the streets of London. I'll show you something to make you change your mind."

This song tells us that no matter how bad that our troubles might be, there are many other people who would trade places with us.

"Ha visto el hombre viejo en el mercado cerrado, recogiendo los papeles en sus zapatos desgastados. En sus ojos no ves orgullo y ahí colgando a lado ves el periódico de ayer, diciendo las noticias de ayer/

Y en el café de toda la noche, son un cuarto después de las once, el mismo hombre ahí sentado a solas. Mirando al mundo sobre el borde de su taza de té, cada té dura una hora y luego deambula solo a casa/

Ha visto el hombre viejo afuera de la misión de un capitán, su memoria se aleja mientras el usa sus medallas. Y en la ciudad de invierno, la lluvia llora un poco de piedad, pues es un héroe más olvidado, y a el mundo no le importa/

Ha visto a la mujer vieja que camina por las calles de Londres, con tierra en su cabello y su vestimento en ragas. No tiene tiempo para platicar, ella sigue por su camino. Llevándola a casa en sus dos bolsas de viaje.

La canción termina con un refrán que dice así, "Como puedes decirme que estas solitario, y decir que para ti el sol no brilla. Deja te tomo de la mano y te llevo por las calles de Londres. Yo te enseñare algo que cambiara tu mente."


