

Donate to the Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA)

We are continuing our ADA campaign after the summer break. The parish is currently behind the 2024 donations at this time last year. The ADA is not a goal to reach but an assessment, that if not reached by the parishioners is paid for by the parish. If the assessment is reached by the parishioners, the parish will receive a refund from the diocese! We are currently over \$67,000 short of our commitment for this year! Fortunately, a generous parishioner has agreed to match any future donations to the ADA this year on a dollar-for-dollar match! Please take advantage of this opportunity to achieve our assessment!

We have over 2500 families registered here at the parish. But only 471 families have made an ADA commitment or pledge to date! This is less than 20% of the parish families. We cannot reach our spiritual capacity to spread the Good News with that level of support! This parish is directly impacted by the ADA. The vocations receive ADA support for both active and retired priests and deacons, including medical and insurance exclusively paid for by the diocese. The ADA also financially supports the training and education of priests and deacons, along with the entire cost of supporting seminarians.




