
From the Principal's Desk

- Our district code is STJO-FL and is typed in the district code field
- Look down towards the bottom of the screen and you will see "Create New ParentsWeb Account" you will need to click on that link
- Enter the district code again STJO-FL
- Enter a valid email address
- Select "create new account"
- A prompt will inform you that an email has been sent to you so that you can create a user name and password.
- Please check your email and create your username and password.
- That should do it!! Make sure to write the district code (STJO-FL), your user name and password down for future use!!

# Remote Area Medical to provide FREE medical care in Bradenton, FL

RAM seeking volunteer vision and dental professionals to treat people in need.

**Bradenton, FL – August 16, 2019** – Remote Area Medical- RAM® -- a major non-profit provider of mobile clinics delivering free, high-quality medical, dental, and vision care to underserved and uninsured individuals—is coming to Bradenton October 12 and 13. Services available at the RAM clinic include dental cleanings, dental fillings, dental extractions, dental x-rays, eye exams, eyeglass prescriptions, eyeglasses made on-site, women's health exams, and general medical exams. **All RAM services are free, and no ID is required.** 

The RAM clinic will be located at Manatee Technical College, 6305 State Road 70 East, Bradenton, FL 34203. The clinic parking lot will open at 12:01 a.m. on Saturday, October 12. Ticket distribution begins at 3 a.m., and patients will be seen in chronological order according to their ticket number when clinic doors open at 6 a.m. This process will repeat on Sunday, October 13.

The number of people the clinic can serve is determined by the number of dental and optometric professionals who volunteer.

"I urge dental professionals to step up to help those within our community who can't afford the care they need," stated Dr. Steven Tinsworth, DMD. "The gratitude of the patients I help is beyond measurement. I get back as much as I give when I volunteer during RAM."

Remote Area Medical has been providing free dental, vision, medical, and veterinary care to the Bradenton, Florida community since 2015. The last four annual clinics at Manatee Technical College provided more than a million dollars' worth of free health care services to thousands of individuals.

### **Guitar Class Information**

**Dear Parents and Guitar** 

8/25/2019

I will continue to teach three days of after-school guitar classes, this year.

**Note:** Intermediate classes will be held on Tuesday and Thursday. Beginning Guitar classes Will continue on Wednesday.

#### Students,

- 1.) Students who attended **last** year's intermediate guitar classes are all encouraged to attend these classes this year.
- 2.) Students, who attended last year's Beginning Guitar class, will continue attending those classes. Those students may be able to advance to the intermediate classes, once I have had the opportunity to assess their overall progress.
- 3.) This year I am accepting new students from first to eighth grade into the Beginning Guitar class. Both Beginning and Intermediate guitar classes will be limited to 25 students each. All students from last year's classes will have first priority to enter this year's classes.
- 4.) <u>Important Note to Parents: All</u> students must be picked up promptly by 4:00 pm at the black gate located at the back, north corner of the church choir room, near the boys' bathroom. Those students not picked up by 4:15 pm will be sent to St. Joseph's After Care.

\*\*\*Snacks: Students may bring a quick snack to eat on the bench outside the church choir room before class starts from 3:00 to 3:15 pm.

### Requirements/Materials for Guitar Class

- A) All students must supply their own guitars, straps and guitar cases.
- B) Younger and new students can purchase new ½ size guitars, cases, straps tuners on line from Amazon, some are sold as a package deal, this seams to be the better deal. The cost is between \$50-\$100 plus. Watch for sales on them. Try to purchase nylon string guitars. Note: I have had to change the steel guitar strings to nylon strings for most students, as the steel strings are hard on a student's fingers. The cost for new nylon strings is approx. \$10.00. I will purchase the correct strings for you, and you can reimburse me for the cost. I do not charge to change strings or to adjust the guitars (if they can be adjusted).
- C) Older students need to purchase larger 3/4 to full size guitars, straps, and guitar cases. If you need assistance in finding guitars, please contact me and I will assist you in finding them.
- D) All students need to purchase: The Complete Edition (Books 1,2,3 bound together in one easy-to-use volume) of *The Hal Leonard Guitar Method* book with ON LINE ACCESS TO 164 FULL-BAND TRACKS FOR DEMONSTRATION OR PLAY ALONG SONGS. ISBN 9780634047015, (PLASTIC COMB BINDER. Books are available ONLINE AT AMAZON.COM. (See attached Amazon page).
- E) All students need to supply a 1", three-ringed binder (any color) for class and homework music pages.
- F) All students need to bring their guitars and three-ringed binders to every class and take them home after class in order to practice and to study at home.
