The Society of the Propagation of the Faith was founded in Lyon, France, in 1822. The first collection of the Propagation of the Faith, in 1822, supported the Diocese of Louisiana and the Florida Territory in the United States, as well as the missions in China. The United States Catholic Conference of Bishops (USCCB) states the following about the Society on its website: "Through the Propagation of the Faith we help preach the Gospel, aid missionaries, and support the development of local churches."

It is interesting that in some small way our roots of faith were nurtured and helped to grow by this organization almost 200 years ago. Every year we are asked to give back to an organization that helped us so many years ago, so that it can help others in some of the poorest parts of the world today. Here is a small list of some of the ways donations are used:

\$25 – feeds 100 vulnerable children at a mission school in Haiti

\$80 – gives classroom supplies to a catechist in Madagascar

\$100 - provides medical care for the elderly in Uganda

\$250 - helps train lay pastoral workers in Sri Lanka

\$500 – helps build a new parish chapel in Papua New Guinea This weekend a missionary from the Society of the Propagation of the Faith will be with us at each Mass.
