

# Coming Home to Mass

With the lifting of most pandemic gathering restrictions last week, Bishop McManus has announced the restoration of the obligation to take part in Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, effective June 6, 2021.

Bishop McManus has also modified those adaptations of liturgical practices which we have been observing for the past year in mitigation of the virus. As of May 29th, masks and social distancing are no longer required of all parishioners. However, per CDC quidelines, non-vaccinated persons are still encouraged to wear masks and maintain social distancing.

The tape has been removed, therefore, from all but a portion of the church. Social distancing pews are located along both side walls of the church.
