Faith Formation News:
Hello families! Summer is in full swing and in case your kids are saying "we are bored already" here are some ideas for local day trips to explore some Catholic history and experience new places with your kids!


The National Shrine of the Divine Mercy- located in Stockbridge, Massachusetts amid the Berkshire Mountains. Visitors can participate in the life of the shrine, which is run by the Marian Fathers of the Immaculate Conception, the official promoters of the Divine Mercy message. Holy Hour, Mass, and the Rosary are all open to visitors.

St. Stephen's Church-located in Boston, just a 3 minute walk from the Old North Church, following the Freedom Trail you will find St. Stephen's Church. This church dates back to 1804 and is the last remaining church in Boston designed by the architect Charles Bulfinch who built the United States Capitol.


Basilica & Shrine of Our Lady of Perpetual Help- built by the Redemptorists in 1874 in the Mission Hill neighborhood of Boston. Our Lady of Perpetual Help is both a basilica and a shrine and has always served immigrants and the poor.

St. Anne Shrine- this sanctuary is located in the Diocese of Worcester and is staffed by the Augustinians of the Assumption. In a large park-like setting consisting of 35 acres of rolling hills and woodlands there are numerous buildings, statues and shrines to see.
