Earlier this summer, we had a parish meeting to discuss the possible sale of part of the cemetery property. Seventy people attended that meeting. We took a straw vote on whether to continue exploring the sale or not; the results were split 50/50. At that time it was agreed that we should have two acres of that land appraised. The cost for that came in higher than I expected. As of September 1st, the diocese will tax any property sale at 15%. Considering that the desire to move forward with a sale was not overwhelming, the higher than expected appraisal, and the 15% tax, it is not advantageous to move forward with a sale at this time. 


There will be a Christmas Faire meeting on Oct. 11, 2023 **Christmas** immediately following the monthly meal. Starting approximately 6:30pm.
