St. Thomas Aquinas surpassed all his fellow students in learning and virtue. He entered the order of St. Domenic against his parents wishes and perserved in his vocation. He studied under St. Albert the Great and at age 22 began teaching and publishing his first works. At age 31 he received his doctorate. He wrote and preached often and was one of the greatest and influential theologians of all time. He is one of the few Doctors of the church. He is the patron of universities and students.
