

### Liturgy Notes

This is the solemnity of All Saints. The vigil of this feast as we all know is "Halloween". These days the origin of the Feast of All Saints is seemingly lost to the world in a sea of snickers and goblins, sweet tarts and fairy princesses. But here at St. Edward as in Catholic parishes throughout the world we celebrate on the first of November the resurrection of the dead and the dedication of the living to sainthood in the Kingdom of Heaven. We celebrate in fact the living stones that make up the very walls of this church, this church within which we move and live and have our being.

This solemnity was instituted to honor all the saints, known and unknown, and, according to Pope Urban IV, to make up for any saints' feasts we may have missed celebrating during the year. In the early days Christians were accustomed to making holy the anniversary of a martyr's death for Christ at the place of martyrdom. Churches were often built at these sites and eventually parish communities began to be dedicated to particular saints. As persecutions of the early church increased the number of martyrs became so great that a separate day could not be assigned to each. The Church, feeling that every martyr should be venerated, appointed a common day for all. St. Ephrem the Syrian mentions a common day in a sermon as early as the year 373.

Yet even before Ephrem, John speaks to us of the building blocks, the living stones of our church, those who were sealed by the blood of the lamb. Those awaiting as John tells us, An angel holding the seal of the living God whose purpose is to put the seal on the foreheads of the servants of our God. John has a vision of a great multitude, which no one could count, from every nation, race, people, and tongue. These have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the lamb.
