

# PASTORAL MESSAGE

# My Dear Parishioners:

Last Saturday, we celebrated the Solemnity of All Saints and Sunday, the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day). Every year on All Souls Day, I feel an urge to visit a cemetery to pray for those departed souls who may not have families to pray for them or who need one more prayer to be released from their suffering. When I visited Memorial Oak Cemetery last Sunday, I felt such a great sense of inner-peace after praying for the souls there. In our church, we are taught that these are important feasts in the liturgical year. On these days, we focus our prayerful attention on the fullness of the church, which includes not only the living, but equally the saints in heaven and the souls in purgatory. By recalling the



interdependence, we have the saints in heaven interceding for us on earth and us on earth interceding for the souls in purgatory. We are prayfully reminded how much we need each other in order to obtain the gift of eternal life in heaven. But why do we remember the saints at all? They are in heaven and have no need of our prayers. We remember them not because they need us but rather because we need them. The saints in heaven assist us in two ways: by the example of their earthly lives and by the intercession of their prayers in heaven. From their place in heaven, the saints intercede for us to the Father. We adore God alone. We have a devotion to the Blessed Mother and all the saints as we ask their intercession to the Father. Devotion to the saints is one important element of a balanced spiritual life. Let us never cease to beg the saints to assist us by prayers.

As we look to the parish recap from the numbers, you will notice that we are meeting our monthly obligation for operations from contributions. However, once the balance due from the capital campaign is paid by October of next year, we will still have to make our \$33,000 per month note payment. If contributions increase significantly, there will not be a need for another capital campaign; but if not, we will need another capital campaign next year in order to pay off the balance on the note. We have 3,000 registered families, but only about 600 families (20%) contribute to the parish. In order to provide the services our families need and meet our obligations to the Archdiocese, we need more participation from the other 2,400 families. My challenge is to get more families to commit to supporting the parish. Our goal is to increase the percentage of participation on a regular basis to at least 33% of our families. Let's come together and make this happen for our parish and community.

# Liturgy Notes Feast of the Dedication of St. John Lateran November 9

This Roman Catholic observance commemorates our 34<sup>th</sup> Pope Sylvester's consecration of the Basilica of the Most Holy Savior, commonly known as St. John Lateran, in Rome on November 9, 324. Churches as they are known today—that is, buildings set apart as places of worship—did not exist for the first two centuries of the Christian era; believers gathered in each other's homes. Thus, the pope's public dedication of this church at the beginning of the fourth century was a first in Christianity and merited a special celebration.

St. John Lateran began as the mansion of a wealthy Roman family named Laterani until it was given to the Christians, serving as the residence of popes for a thousand years. The home was built around a great hall, and this hall became the church. It was called a "basilica," a word that originally described an oblong hall, rounded at one or both ends, where public assemblies were held. A baptistry was added and dedicated to St. John the Baptist, and since the 12th century, the church has been known as St. John Lateran.




