Liturgy Notes

When God entered history, He entered by way of the family –the holy Family of Nazareth. He could have chosen other ways to save the world, but he didn't. He's God, and He chose the best way. The Feast of the Holy Family has been celebrated by the universal Church only since 1920. It was originally celebrated on the Third Sunday after Epiphany. Devotion to the Holy Family became popular after the 16th century. The theme of family, and this feast dedicated to it, is of special importance today in face of challenges to the contemporary family.

God's love for us does not grow. It was already larger than the oldest tree long before we were born and will be long after we die. We are children of God and it is through his creation that we grow. Our family is the Body of Christ grown in the full communion of love. For the most part we don't even notice the growth. Somewhere along the way of life God gets lost amid our higher priorities. Then for one moment we slow down long enough to realize that despite our neglect God's love is still strong and we wonder at how that occurred.
