


FEAST OF THE LORD'S BAPTISM

Our Dear Parishioners.

We celebrated last Sunday the Solemnity of the Lord's Epiphany. God manifested Himself to all nations. In and through today's **Solemnity of the Lord's Baptism**, He continues revealing Himself to humankind. The Solemnity of the Lord's Baptism forms a very essential component of the Lord's Epiphany.

God reveals that Jesus Christ is His Beloved Son. Referring to Jesus, His voice is heard: "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." Nothing can be clearer a claim that Jesus is the Son of God than God Himself saying so.

In asserting that Jesus Christ is His Beloved Son, God announces that the Messianic promises (cf. Is 61:1ff) are beginning to be fulfilled in and through



The Lord's Baptism is a continuation of the Lord's Epiphany. But the Lord's Baptism does not conclude the Lord's Epiphany. Today, the Lord continues revealing Himself to us. I do not mean that He makes new revelations – Jesus Christ is the final and definitive revelation of God; after Jesus and besides Jesus, there are no more revelations to come – but that in and through us, baptized in the name of the Most Holy Trinity, God is likewise manifested to the world. By way of identification and participation with Jesus, the Beloved Son of the Father, we continue the Epiphany of God. This is our privilege and our mission. In other words, our own baptism means two things. First, it proclaims publicly our new membership of the Church and second, it empowers us to do the good works Jesus did.

Are we ready to consecrate and dedicate ourselves wholly to the service of the Kingdom of God just as Jesus does?
