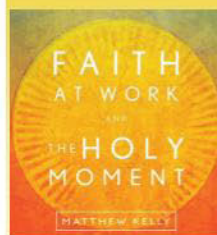


Couples for Christ-Foundation for Family & Life

Couples for Christ – Foundation for Family and Life (CFC-FFL) is an ecclesial movement, or canonically, a private lay association that aims to build the “church of the home” by bringing families to a living relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ. It began in 1981 when 16 couples tried a new approach in living out their Christian life in an active and supportive relationship with one another. Eventually, CFC-FFL became a Christian family life renewal program available to parishes and groups of married couples who wished to renew the power of the Holy Spirit among them through a series of weekly informal discussions of the gospel in a social setting. The movement is now in 161 countries worldwide. This ministry has also expanded to include programs for Kids, Youth, Singles, Handmaids, and Servants. CFC-FFL is a servant and lay arm of the Roman Catholic Church in the work of evangelization, family renewal, and the promotion and defense of life. Those who want to become members of CFC-FFL attend a local Christian Life Seminar which is a series of 9 talks dealing with Christian catechesis. The sessions consist of a talk, group discussion, and time for fellowship. In response to Pope St. John Paul II, Pope Benedict and later Pope Francis’ call for New Evangelization, The CFC FFL has also started the LIVE CHRIST SHARE CHRIST (LCSC) Movement in certain parishes. It is a movement for evangelization and renewal, where Catholics are to meet Christ, live Christ and share Christ. LCSC intends to do massive evangelization based in the parishes, reaching the lapse and nominal Catholics.
