



Be rich in good works... ready to share

My dear friends in Christ,

In writing to his friend Timothy, St. Paul gives all Christians the stirring summons to "be rich in good works, ready to share." These words provide the encouraging theme of our Diocesan Services Fund this year, underlining how essential solidarity and generosity are to following the Lord Jesus. Lest we think that he is simply encouraging good behavior, he goes on to emphasize that being rich in good works "accumulates as treasure a good foundation for the future, so as to win the life that is true life." Generosity can thus be an effective remedy for the distractions and self-centeredness that detract from true, eternal life in Christ.

As we begin the Diocesan Services Fund of 2015 this weekend, I hope this generosity in good works and eagerness to share extends concretely to the more than 60 ministries that rely on this annual fund. The DSF film and brochure highlights a number of these ministries.

Young adults who leave home for college or work often find it difficult to continue in their journey with Christ. The DSF ensures that they have excellent opportunities to form and support their faith life in a challenging environment. Retreat programs like Bayou Awakening, Charis Retreats and Café Catholica not only nourish their faith, but equip them to become agents of evangelization in the world. Café Catholica alone attracts over 800 young adults to each of their weekly summer gatherings.

San José Clinic is known to most of us as the original safety-net clinic for those poorest among us who are sick and unable to obtain adequate insurance. The Clinic not only serves these working families in times of serious illnesses but also emphasizes prevention by educating patients both young and old about proper nutrition, diet and exercise to lead a more healthy life.

The Office of Vocations is featured each year in light of the ever-present need for more shepherds to lead our expanding and richly diverse Catholic congregations. Recently-ordained Father Jesse Garcia shares his story of discernment and the significant role played by the Vocations Office in his journey to the priesthood.

The Diocesan Services Fund is a genuine opportunity to share our riches with others and so grow in Christian discipleship. Your help is greatly needed and appreciated, and I encourage you to help sustain these vital ministries by your generous contributions and your prayers. 






Ministry Spotlight Catholic Daughters of America


