

Dear Parishioners:

In our day and time in Spring Texas, we see so many people who try different things for "self-improvement". Especially with the New Year, we see people going to health clubs to lose those extra pounds gained because of holiday sweets and eating. We see people taking classes to learn new technologies like the latest software from Microsoft and others who read self-help books.



What about our spiritual life? In the gospel reading of the second Sunday of Lent, Jesus was transfigured for those with him on the mountain.
