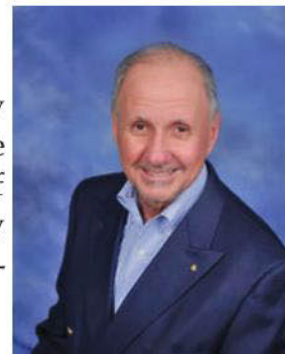


## 2nd Sunday of Lent



Dear Parishioners:

In our day and time in Spring Texas, we see so many people who try different things for “self-improvement”. Especially with the New Year, we see people going to health clubs to lose those extra pounds gained because of holiday sweets and eating. We see people taking classes to learn new technologies like the latest software from Microsoft and others who read self-help books.



What about our spiritual life? In the gospel reading of the second Sunday of Lent, Jesus was transfigured for those with him on the mountain. The **apostle’s view of Jesus** changed because of this experience of the dazzling appearance of Jesus, the vision of Moses and Elijah, and the voice of God.

Our view of God can change in so many ways: through prayer, reading scripture, and just in day to day encounters with special people, who seem to live a life that is an example of the gospel message.

For me, it sometimes happens when I work with AIDS patients or those in varying levels of sickness at the hospital. I see so many people who are in desperate situations, but instead of being angry or depressed, they have a glow or joy about them. They have the presence of God in their hearts...in their eyes. Being with these people can offer a new view of God.

As we make our way through this Lenten season, may we all look for those in need, may we bring the presence of God to those we encounter, and may our hearts be open to experience those who can open our hearts to the Joy of our Lenten season.
