

Everyone's Called to be Evangelists

Dear Parish Family,

The Scripture readings for the Masses during these 40 days following Easter have much to tell us about the New Evangelization. Many think Evangelization—sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ—is a job reserved for the professionals, but we see, for example, Peter and John, two ordinary fishermen, sharing their faith



in Jesus by simply helping a crippled beggar to his feet and healing him in the name of Jesus and proclaiming their faith in Christ as their Risen Lord. What made Peter and John effective evangelists? They were empowered by their companionship with Jesus. Spending more time each day can give us the same faith and courage to be Christ's evangelists.

To know Christ more deeply in faith is to become more aware of his presence in our daily lives, to take a moment from time to time to praise him, to ask for his help, and then take time to listen to him. We need to trust that he's there; that he'll speak when he's ready and when he knows we're ready to hear him. During this Year of Consecrated Life, we need to be convinced with St. Paul that nothing matters more than knowing our Lord Jesus Christ and being with Him and His mission.


