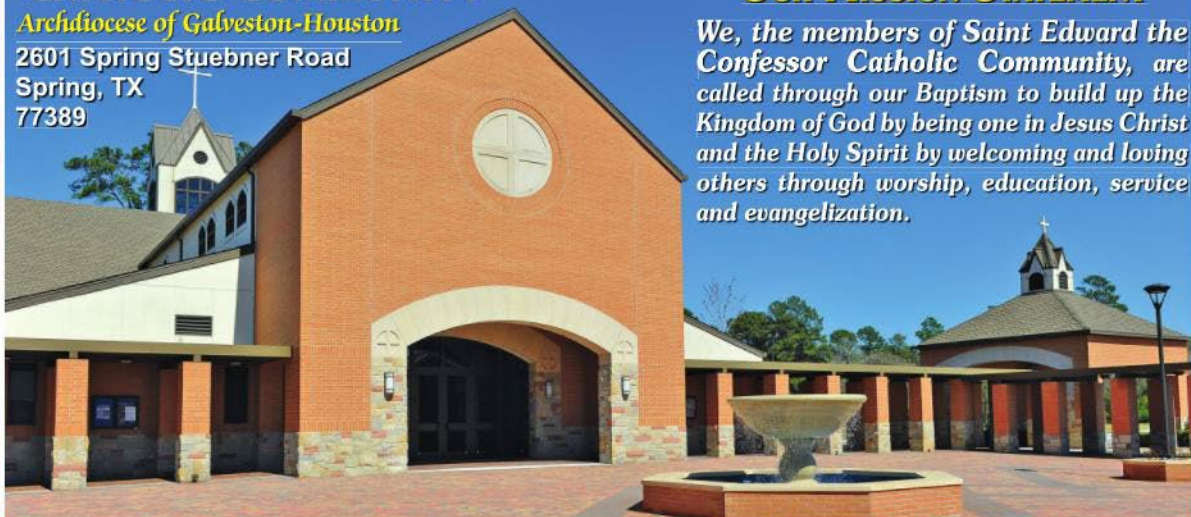

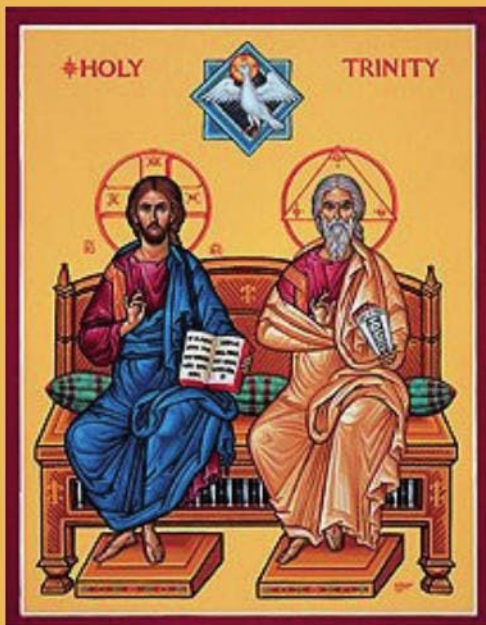

BAPTISM PREPARATION



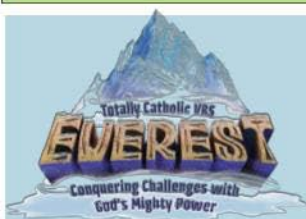

There is no cost for the sessions and pre-registration is not necessary. Birth certificate required for issuance of Baptism certificate. All questions will be addressed at the sessions.

Session I: The Theology & Ritual of Baptism: 7:00pm-8:15pm in the Parish Life Center the 2nd Monday of each month.

Session II: The Domestic Church: Catholic Family Life: 7:00pm-8:15pm in the Parish Life Center the 4th Monday of the month. It is a **required** follow up session for new parents and godparents, but all parishioners are welcome.

Did you know?

May 25, 2015 lifenews.com A federal appeals court has issued a ruling banning Choose Life license plates in New York State and claimed in its decision that pro-life views are "patently offensive." The decision overturned the ruling of a lower court from 2011, which held that blocking the plates was an illegal First Amendment violation. Judge Rosemary Pooler, a Clinton appointee, agreed with New York's position in her majority opinion. Despite these protections, however, she said that so many New Yorkers could find a plate advocating an anti-abortion position "patently offensive" that the DMV was justified in suppressing the speech.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Children (RCIC)

Do you feel called to support, teach and welcome children into the Catholic Church? Children who are un-baptized between the ages of 8-14 have the opportunity to attend RCIC. This is a 2 year process which ends in full initiation to the Catholic Faith. Depending on the age of the child, this includes the following sacraments: Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Eucharist, and Confirmation. The spiritual journey concludes during the Easter Vigil of their second year. RCIC meets on Sundays after the 11:30 Mass in SEEC 22. Parents or Godparents are asked to attend the sessions with the child. Volunteers are always needed to support this beautiful ministry. 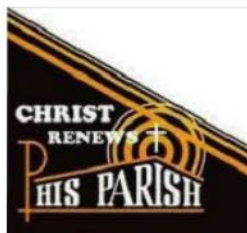
