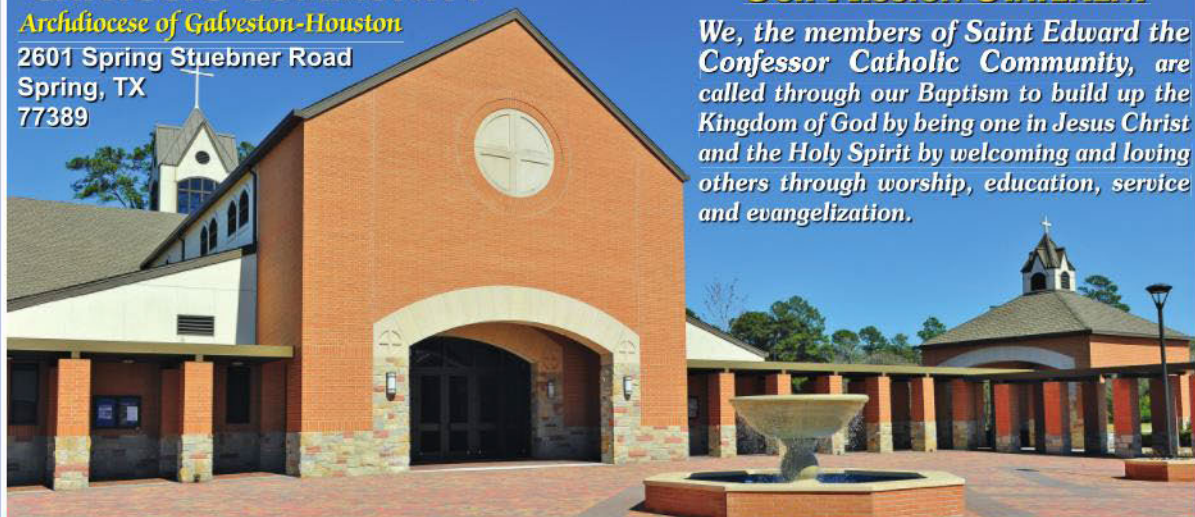

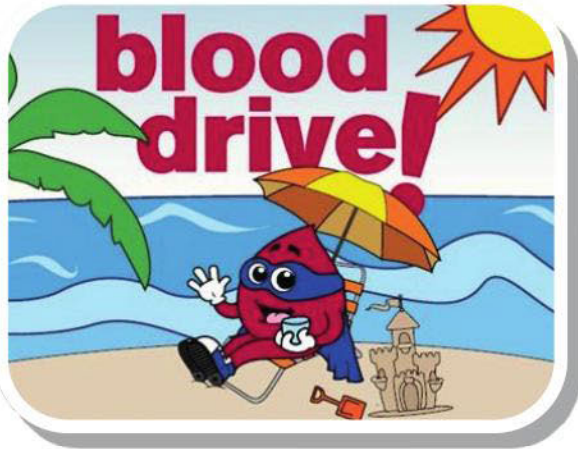

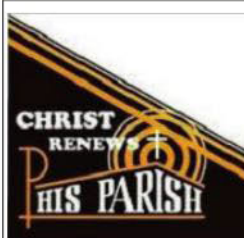

Did You Know?

On June 16, Ohio's legislative committee approved, with bipartisan support, a pro-life bill to ban abortions specifically done on unborn babies who are diagnosed with Down Syndrome. The vote in favor of the measure sends the bill to the full Ohio state House for a vote. Studies show somewhere between 70-90 percent of unborn babies with Down Syndrome are victims of abortion. Ohio is now the second state to accept the ban, with North Dakota being the first.

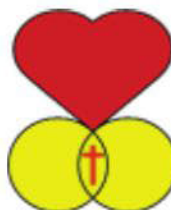
