

VIRTUS TRAINING-PGC

Preventing child sexual abuse is the goal of the Archdiocesan Safe Environment "Protecting God's Children" is the program selected by the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston to educate clergy, staff and volunteers who work with children and youth about child sexual abuse and the ways to create a safe environment for children. The 3-hour live session includes videos and facilitated discussions that focus on the prevention of abuse and the protection of children. Adults learn how to recognize the warning signs of sexual abuse and to respond appropriately. You will learn about steps that the faith community can take to create a safe environment for all God's children and how to respond when adults behave in a way that raises concerns.

On Friday, June 26, 2015, the Supreme Court declared that same sex couples have a right to marry anywhere in the U.S. The Court's 5-4 ruling means that 14 states, in the south and Midwest, including Texas, will have to stop enforcing their bans. Cardinal DiNardo said, "The ruling does not and cannot change what marriage really is. No one and no court can make what is false true."


