



Did You Know? On June 29,2015, the Supreme Court voted 5-4, to block Texas' HB2 law, which requires abortion facilities to meet the same safety standards of other Ambulatory Surgical Centers in the state, ensures that abortionists have admitting privileges at a local hospital, and bans painful late abortions on fully formed babies. Greg Abbott filed an appeal, and abortion clinics appealed to the high court to block the law while the lower court considers the appeal. Texas' pro-life law is credited with closing multiple abortion clinics and cutting abortions 13 percent, saving an estimated 9,900 babies from abortion.


