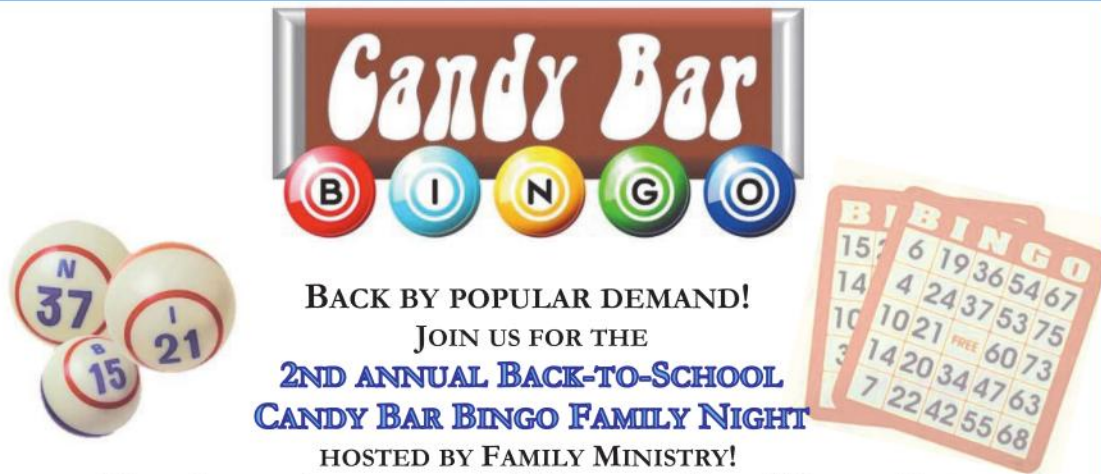

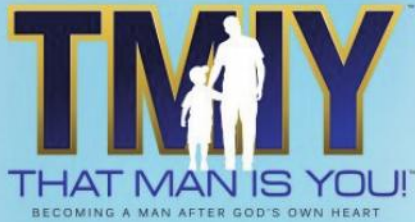

VIRTUS REFRESHER WORKSHOP

"Keeping the Promise Alive" is a mandatory refresher course that went into effect 2011-2012. Employees and volunteers are required to attend **"Keeping the Promise Alive"** after 5 years of attending the "protecting God's Children" workshop. It is a 1.5 hour session with one video that provides ongoing awareness for the prevention of child sexual abuse. The material covered in "Keeping the Promise Alive" is designed to identify and reinforce the lessons of the original "Protecting God's Children" program by clarifying some of the more challenging aspects of the sessions and strengthening the participants' ability to recognize risky behavior by adults in their environment and take action to intervene in potentially threatening situations.

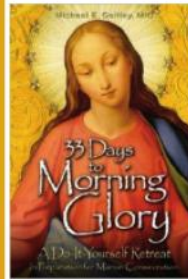
