


VIRTUS REFRESHER WORKSHOP

"Keeping the Promise Alive" is a mandatory refresher course that went into effect 2011-2012. Employees and volunteers are required to attend "Keeping the Promise Alive" after 5 years of attending the "protecting God's Children" workshop. It is a 1.5 hour session one video that provides ongoing awareness for the prevention of child sexual abuse. The material covered in "Keeping the Promise Alive" is designed to identify and reinforce the lessons of the original "Protecting God's Children" program by clarifying some of the more challenging aspects of the sessions and strengthening the participants' ability to recognize risky behavior by adults in their environment and take action to intervene in potentially threatening situations.

Have you ever wondered how the church transforms overnight at Easter Christmas? How and why we suddenly change from green to purple during the year? The Art and Environment ministry, under the leadership of Thompson, makes Nick transformations to reflect the Church liturgical year. The ministry members help prepare and decorate the church for the six liturgical seasons: Advent, Christmas, Lent, Sacred Paschal Triduum, Easter, and Ordinary Time.

Deacon Nick encourages parishioners to come "join the fun" and states that "more volunteers are always needed and welcome." The exact time commitment varies depending upon the Church liturgical season. The planning meetings take place in the Parish Life Center meeting room and typically occur on the Friday evening prior to a liturgical season and color change. The preparation for the Sacred Paschal Triduum normally takes place on the Monday evening prior to Ash Wednesday. Please watch the bulletin for requests for assistance with these seasonal change preparations as the Church colors change from green to violet (purple), white and red.
