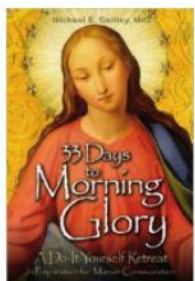

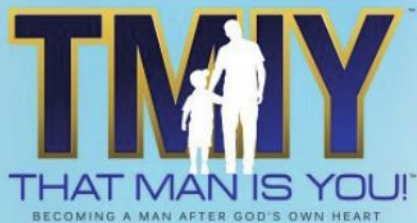

### Christ Renews His Parish (CRHP)

Have you always wanted to attend a retreat but didn't want to travel far or pay a lot of money? Are you looking for a deeper connection with Christ as well as your parish? For the past 7 years, St. Edward has participated in a renewal process known as Christ Renews His Parish (CRHP). This process began in 1969 in Ohio and has since spread to more than 1200 parishes in 35 states in the US and in 5 other countries. More than 140 women from our parish have attended the two-day retreat over the past 7 years. While many people who experience the process experience it at different levels of intensity, most would say it is an authentic encounter with God. People describe experiencing God more intimately, more personal. From those with little faith, to those who have been ordained for many years, all leave with a renewed experience with the Holy Spirit. As individuals are renewed the Holy Spirit moves in the community and in the spiritual life of the parish. The weekend itself is relaxed and friendships are formed that go on long after the weekend retreat is done. There are opportunities to continue to work with CRHP, but the primary focus, as the name implies, is renewing the parish as a whole. The church at St. Edward has benefited from CRHP as many of the women have become more active in various ministries in our parish.
