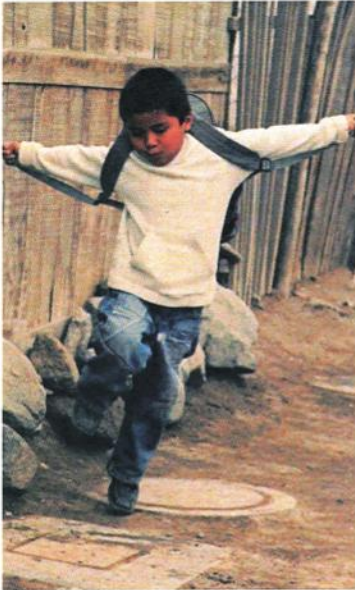

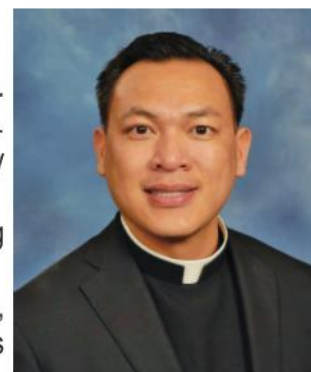
please pray for our safe journey. I will remember all of you in my prayers and thoughts. I thank God for your faithfulness and support.

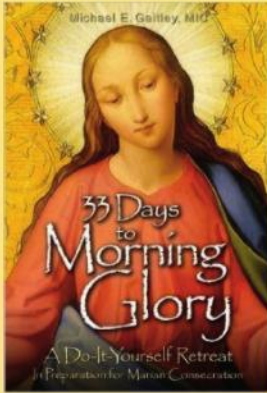


ATTENTION ALL SINGERS!

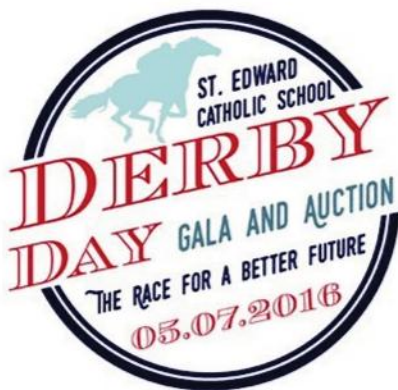
