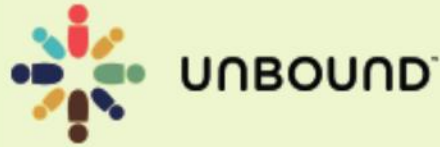

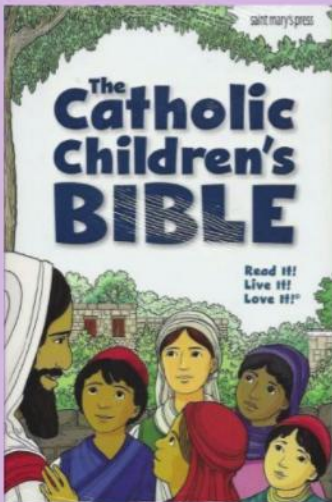


Dear Parishioners of St. Edward Parish,
