


We are encouraging both the school and the parish to participate in this year's Steps-4-Students program which occurs on Saturday, 20 February 2016. This event last year raised over

Did You Know?

On January 8, 2016, President Barack Obama vetoed the bill, which was approved by both houses of Congress, that would de-fund the Planned Parenthood abortion business.
