ST. EDWARD CATHOLIC SCHOOL: RAISING FUNDS FOR THE NEW SCHOOL

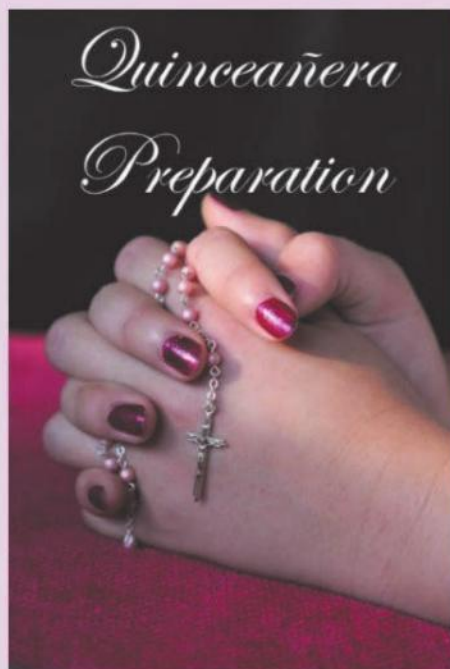

Martha's Moms

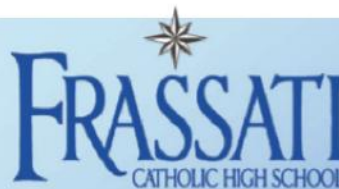

Did You Know?

On January 8, 2016, President Barack Obama vetoed the bill, which was approved by both houses of Congress, that would de-fund the Planned Parenthood abortion business.
