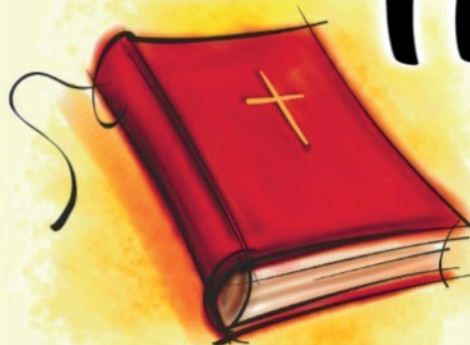
Did You Know?

A Texas grand jury indicted David Daleiden and another pro-life activist, Sandra Merritt, behind the videos that exposed Planned Parenthood's secret of selling babies' body parts after aborting them.
