LECTIO DIVINA

Lectio Divina is one of the great treasures of the Christian tradition of prayer. This tradition of prayer flows out of a Hebrew method of studying the Scriptures, which was called haggadah. Haggadah was an interactive interpretation of the Scriptures by means of the free use of the text to explore its inner meaning. It was part of the devotional practice of the Jews in the days of Jesus.

The ancient practice of Lectio Divina (Divine Reading) - the prayerful reading of Scripture - is being rediscovered and renewed in our time. Notice that it is a prayer tradition. We need to distinguish Lectio Divina from Bible or Scripture study, which provides a solid conceptual background for the practice of Lectio Divina but is best done at another time. Scripture study is a way of exploring the stories and teachings of a religious tradition through analysis of its sacred texts. Lectio Divina is a contemplative practice that is a direct way of connecting to and relating with God.

Come join us as we continue the celebration of Easter to Pentecost with 6 sessions of the prayer of Lectio Divina and Centering Prayer. Helping The Very Poor To See
NEEDED: Used Eye Glasses



My name is Seth Fagan. For my Eagle Project, I am collecting 1,000+ pair of glasses that I will donate to a surgical organization called the Guerrero Eye Clinic and Surgery Center. They send surgeons several times a year to perform free cataract surgeries for the extremely poor in and around Guerrero, Mexico, located in the state of Chihuahua. The clinic performs over 1,500 eye exams annually, from those they perform cataract surgery on an average of 600. My goal is to help their efforts by providing vision aids. The glasses I collect will be dispersed by their professionals free of charge to the patients in need. I am asking you to donate any of the following that you no longer use: prescription eye glasses, readers, sunglasses, frames, and cases.

Many times when people have their prescription change, the strength of their readers increase, or they just get "newer" frames, they put their old glasses in a drawer and forget about them. Now, I urge you to donate them and help me provide them to those less fortunate than us. Together, we can greatly improve lives.
