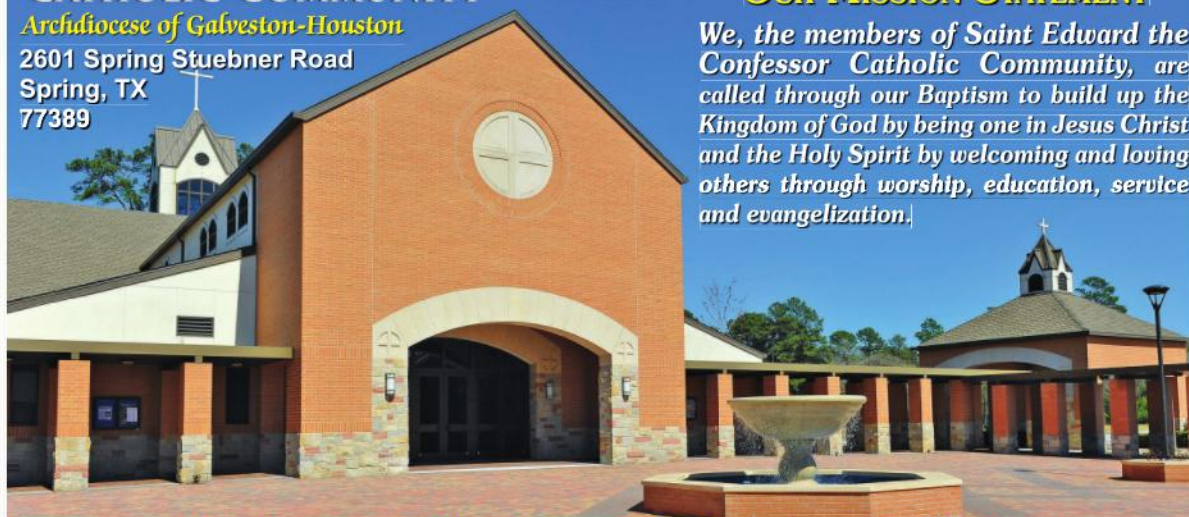

Dear Parishioners:

As we journey through this holy season of Lent toward the great events of Holy Week, Palm Sunday ushers us into Holy Week. This sacred week is meant for us to be a time of intense remembrance of the Paschal Mystery; that is, the events of the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.

The Paschal Mystery is commemorated intensely during the Holy Triduum; Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday with the Vigil of the Lord's Resurrection. These three sacred days are set aside for us Catholics to focus on the immeasurable love of God, "Who so loved the world that He gave up HIS only Son Jesus to redeem us". (Jn 3, 16)

The Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ obtained for us the beautiful gift of New Life, personally and as a community. New Life means a new way of looking at the totality of life; a new manner of relationship with those around us; a new pattern of actions and a new impetus and direction for our day to day living. New Life proclaims the sacredness of life from its conception. The newness of this life is the person of Jesus Christ Himself, who through His death and Resurrection, made all things new and restored them to the Father. We are made new by the self-offering and sacrifice of Jesus on Calvary and by His glorious Resurrection. (cfr.Col.3,1-4)

My brothers and sisters in Christ, it is up to us to benefit from the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. It is up to us to allow the Risen Christ to influence our person. It is up to us to follow the way to the New Life. Jesus proclaims: "I am the way, the truth and the life." (Jn 14:6)

At the Chrism Mass, Fr. Mario and I, together with all the priests throughout the Archdiocese, will renew our promises. Please pray for us so that we can renew our priesthood in that Paschal Mystery of sacrifice, obedience, love and zealous service.

Jesus Christ calls us to holiness of life. I ask you to reflect and live the beautiful gift of being a lay faithful in the Catholic Church. You have much to offer to make our Church vibrant and dynamic. Be a tremendous source of inspiration to your fellow lay faithful by your deep faith in Almighty God. Live to its fullest your name as Christians, as Catholics, by following Jesus in and through His body, the Church. Let your devotions and piety be expressed fully in the service of your families and your parish.

May our blessed Mother who endured most of the sufferings of her Son, strengthen us always and lead us to the experience of the joy of her Son's glorious resurrection.

As Christians, we are participants in the glories of Easter. For through our baptism, we too have been raised to a new life in Christ. This will be my third Holy Week and Easter with you, and I pray for all of you from the bottom of my heart that you each have a spiritual Lent and wonderful Easter celebration.

For followers of Catholicism, no time during the year is as meaningful as the season of Lent. Traditionally, many symbolic gestures are made during Lent. Catholics fast, abstain from eating meat on Fridays, make special sacrifices.

In the dioceses of the United States as determined by the USCCB, statues and crosses in the church building may be covered with veils beginning on the vigil of the fifth Sunday of Lent and continuing until Good Friday, known as Passiontide. Crosses must however be removed or covered after the Holy Thursday evening Mass until completion of the Good Friday service.

The purpose of covering the crosses is to emphasize the cross being revealed on Good Friday. The purpose of covering other images is to take the focus off the images and focus the attention of the people on the central mysteries of our faith -- the death and resurrection of Jesus.

Another practice of the Church has been to empty the Holy Water fonts on the days of the Sacred Triduum in preparation of the blessing of the water at the Easter Vigil. Dioceses in the United States are asked not to confer Baptisms or Confirmations from Monday to Friday of Holy Week except in danger of death.

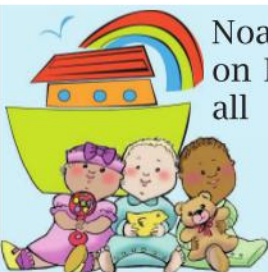
YOUTH CHOIR—EASTER

NURSERY CLOSED ON EASTER SUNDAY

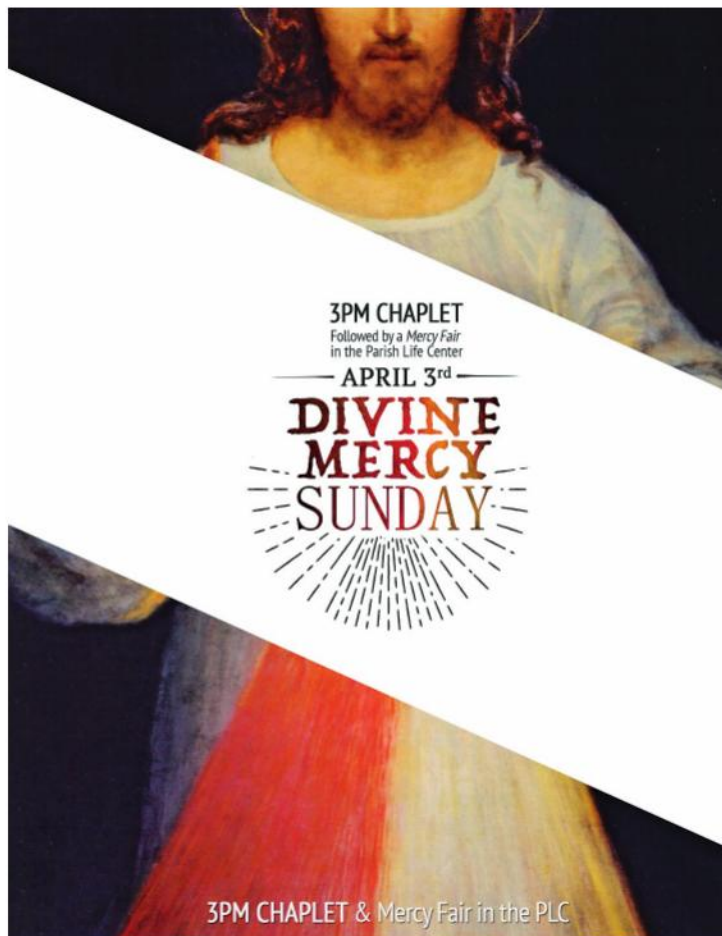


Noah's Nursery will be closed on Easter Sunday in order for all of our volunteers to celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ with their families!

PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

Preventing child sexual abuse is the goal of the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Office. "Protecting God's Children" is the program selected by the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston to educate clergy, staff, and volunteers who work with children and youth about child sexual abuse and the ways to create a safe environment for children. The 3-hour live session includes videos and facilitated discussions that focus on the prevention of abuse and the protection of children. Adults learn how to recognize the warning signs of sexual abuse and to respond appropriately. You will learn about steps that the faith community can take to create a safe environment for all God's children and how to respond when adults behave in a way that raises concerns.

A "Protecting God's Children" workshop will be held at St. Edward Parish on April 16, 2016 from 9:00am-12:00 noon in the Parish Life Center.

You must arrive at least 30 minutes early and pre-register for this workshop online. We do not allow late admittance or walk-ins. You will need to re-schedule if you arrive late or do not pre-register online for this workshop.

There is no babysitting. No minor child, toddler or infant is permitted in the workshop. There is no exception to this. Do not bring children or youth to the class.

All attendees must have a current Driver's license (any state), State-issued Identification Card, Passport (any country), Mexico or Guatemala Consulate ID in order to attend a "Protecting God's Children" Workshop. LECTIO DIVINA

Lectio Divina is one of the great treasures of the Christian tradition of prayer. This tradition of prayer flows out of a Hebrew method of studying the Scriptures, which was called haggadah. Haggadah was an interactive interpretation of the Scriptures by means of the free use of the text to explore its inner meaning. It was part of the devotional practice of the Jews in the days of Jesus.

The ancient practice of Lectio Divina (Divine Reading) - the prayerful reading of Scripture - is being rediscovered and renewed in our time. Notice that it is a prayer tradition. We need to distinguish Lectio Divina from Bible or Scripture study, which provides a solid conceptual background for the practice of Lectio Divina. Scripture study is a way of exploring the stories and teachings of a religious tradition through analysis of its sacred texts. Lectio Divina is a contemplative practice that is a direct way of connecting to and relating with God.

Come join us as we continue the celebration of Easter to Pentecost with 6 sessions of the prayer of Lectio Divina and Centering Prayer.
