My Dear Parishioners:

Along with the Serenity Prayer, many people recovering from various addictions have found strength in saying the following prayer daily:

“Lord, help me to be satisfied with ordinary contentment  
And not be looking for extraordinary happiness.”

People who are addicted to such things as alcohol, drugs and food are deceived into thinking these things will bring them extraordinary happiness. They may bring them moments of fleeting pleasure, but they will always fall short of the promise of perfect happiness. Instead, after “acting out”, the addict experiences such negative feelings as shame, guilt & anxiety.

Whether we are addicts or not, I think the above prayer can remind all of us of Christ’s promise, “I’ve come that you may have life and have it more abundantly”. ## MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT



### World Apostolate of Fatima - Blue Army Group



Do you feel a special connection to the Blessed Mother? Is she calling you to be a prayer warrior for her children in need? While Our Lady’s call for the conversion of sinners is directed toward all of her children, her devotional requests are uniquely and specifically directed at the Catholics of the world. This is so because it is Catholics whose Church teaching supports the belief that we can merit grace for ourselves and for others, who wear scapulars and consecrate their lives to Mary, who pray the rosary, and who have at their disposal the sacraments of Confession and Holy Communion. This means that primary responsibility for the fulfillment of heaven’s desire where Fatima Devotions are concerned rests upon the shoulders of the Catholics of the world. The devotional requests of Our Lady of Fatima provide the precise weapons of spiritual warfare so desperately needed today. St. Edward Church established A World Apostolate of Fatima Blue Army Prayer Cell in October of 2011. The group consists of 8 parishioners who come together on a regular basis to honor Our Lady’s requests for prayer, penance and sacrifice in reparation for sin and in supplication for the conversion of sinners, the salvation of souls and world peace. They offer up every day sacrifices demanded by their daily duty of Morning Offering, pray the Rosary daily while meditating on the Mysteries, wear the Scapular of Mount Carmel as a profession of their promise and consecration to Mary, and fulfill the requirements of the First Five Saturday Devotion. They also participate in many spiritual activities throughout the year including praying the Patriotic Rosary on specific holidays, the Public Square Rosary Rally, the Hour of Grace, celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday and as a cell they read 33 Days of Morning Glory do-it-yourself retreat for their consecration to Mary. The group currently meets every Wednesday from 6:00 PM – 6:30 PM in the Parlor in the Narthex and then from 6:30 PM – 8:30 PM in the Chapel. ### Did You Know?

An amazing new discovery is bringing more attention to the fact that human life begins at the moment of fertilization.

Scientists at Northwestern University in Chicago said they witnessed for the first time what happens at the moment when a new human life begins – a burst of zinc fireworks. The Telegraph reports the scientists released a video with their research that shows the stunning discovery. The video shows a flash of light occurring at the moment when a human sperm joins with an egg to form a unique new human life, according to the study.

“We discovered the zinc spark just five years ago in the mouse, and to see the zinc radiate out in a burst from each human egg was breathtaking,” said Dr. Teresa Woodruff, a professor at Northwestern. “It was remarkable.”
