Did You Know?

An amazing new discovery is bringing more attention to the fact that human life begins at the moment of fertilization.

Scientists at Northwestern University in Chicago said they witnessed for the first time what happens at the moment when a new human life begins – a burst of zinc fireworks. The Telegraph reports the scientists released a video with their research that shows the stunning discovery. The video shows a flash of light occurring at the moment when a human sperm joins with an egg to form a unique new human life, according to the study.

“We discovered the zinc spark just five years ago in the mouse, and to see the zinc radiate out in a burst from each human egg was breathtaking,” said Dr. Teresa Woodruff, a professor at Northwestern. “It was remarkable.”
