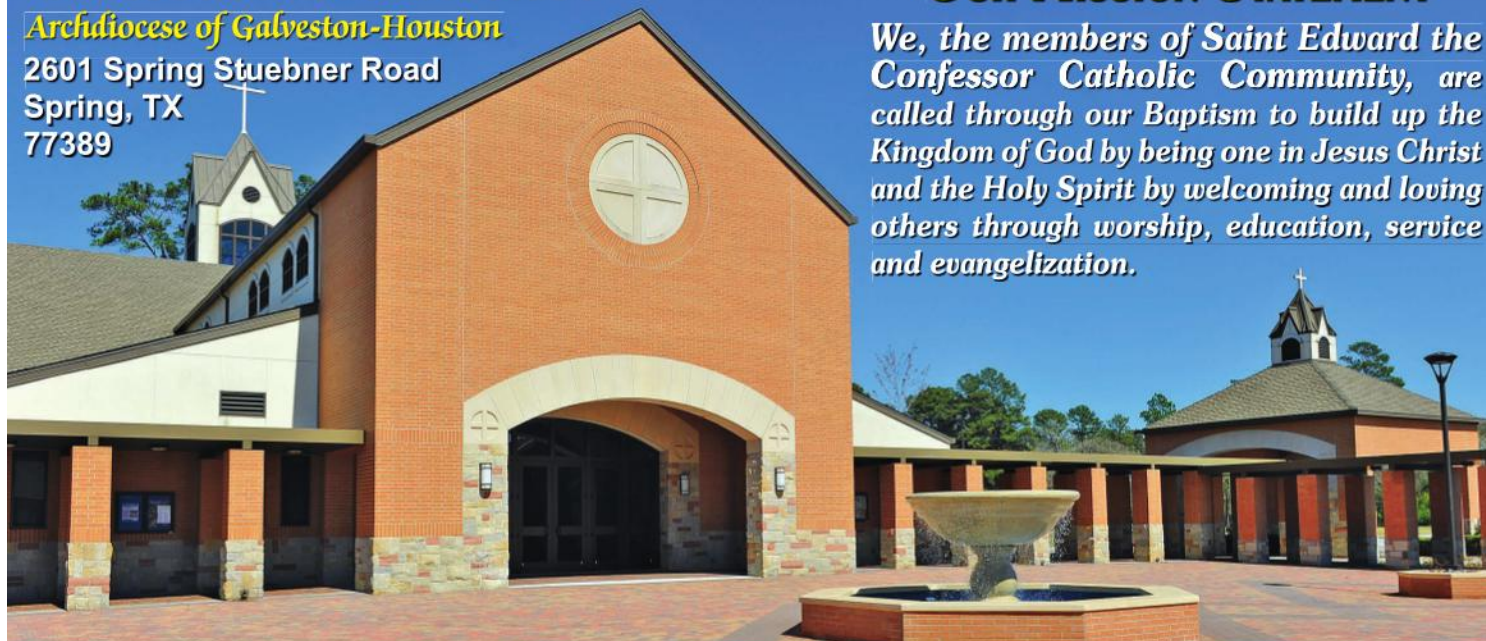

The lay ministers who fulfill the role of Lectors deliver the Word of God to the faithful during the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on Sundays, Holy Days, and at daily Masses. When we receive the Readings from Sacred Scripture at Holy Mass, we are directly encountering Jesus Christ, the Word of God, a word that accomplishes what it says. Our readers have discerned a call to this ministry from the Holy Spirit: a call to commit to serving at liturgies as scheduled, a call to using their talents and skills to deliver effectively the message of their assigned readings, and a call to continuous formation in their knowledge and understanding of Sacred Scripture. Our parish has a number of participants in this ministry, so ministers serve an average of 9 Sundays a year. St. Edward Church provides mandatory training each fall. Our Lectors are committed to spending the necessary time in preparation and practice in order to effectively proclaim their assigned readings. 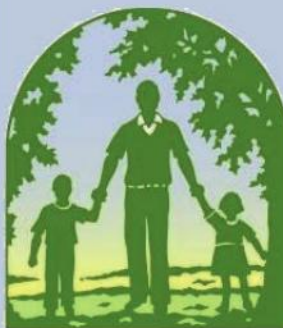
