Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

God speaks to us in many ways, including through the Sunday Scripture readings. As we spend our time in daily reflection and examination of conscience, we can ask ourselves how much time we spend on our outward appearance and trying to please others, versus the time we spend in daily conversation with Christ, deepening our relationship with him.

How are we balancing the needs of our faith with our emotional, physical and social needs? Are we more like Martha, with our priorities focused on pleasing and serving those around us, or are we more like Mary, focused on our time spent with Christ?

Jesus makes it clear in today's Gospel that the fruits of Martha's labor are temporary – they will be gobbled up by her guests – but what Mary has gained from her time spent with him will last forever. "It will not be taken from her."

We, too, can make the same choice. We can start today by expanding our time in reflection and conversation with God by 10, 15 or even 20 minutes. We can be more like Mary and less like Martha.

May the days of summer be light for all of us and may His light shine in us always!

## PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

Preventing child sexual abuse is the goal of the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Office. "Protecting God's Children" is the program selected by the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston to educate clergy, staff, and volunteers who work with children and youth about child sexual abuse and the ways to create a safe environment for children. The 3-hour live session includes videos and facilitated discussions that focus on the prevention of abuse and the protection of children. Adults learn how to recognize the warning signs of sexual abuse and to respond appropriately. You will learn about steps that the faith community can take to create a safe environment for all God's children and how to respond when adults behave in a way that raises concerns.

**A "Protecting God's Children" workshop will be held at St. Edward Parish on August 13, 2016 from 9:00am-12:00 noon in the Parish Life Center.**

**You must arrive at least 30 minutes early and pre-register for this workshop online. We do not allow late admittance or walk-ins. You will need to re-schedule if you arrive late or do not pre-register online for this workshop.**

There is no babysitting. No minor child, toddler or infant is permitted in the workshop. There is no exception to this. Do not bring children or youth to the class.

All attendees must have a current Driver's license (any state), State-issued Identification Card, Passport (any country), Mexico or Guatemala Consulate ID in order to attend a "Protecting God's Children" Workshop. When pre-registering for the class, **YOU MUST USE YOUR NAME and DATE OF BIRTH** as it appears on your DL, ID, or Passport. ## KEEPING THE PROMISE ALIVE

**"Keeping the Promise Alive"** is a mandatory refresher course that went into effect 2011-2012. Employees and volunteers are required to attend "Keeping the Promise Alive" after 5 years of attending the "Protecting God's Children"® program. It is a 1.5 hour session with one video that provides ongoing awareness for the prevention of child sexual abuse. The material covered in "Keeping the Promise Alive" is designed to identify and reinforce the lessons of the original "Protecting God's Children" program by clarifying some of the more challenging aspects of the sessions and strengthening the participants' ability to recognize risky behavior by adults in their environments and take action to intervene in potentially threatening situations.

**A "Keeping the Promise Alive" workshop will be held at St. Edward Parish on August 10, 2016 from 7pm-8:30pm in the Parish Life Center.**

**You must arrive at least 30 minutes early and pre-register for this workshop online. We do not allow late admittance or walk-ins. You will need to re-schedule if you arrive late or do not pre-register online for this workshop.**

## MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT EMHC



The Sacrament of the Most Holy Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life, the sum and summary of our Faith. When we participate in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass the saving sacrifice of our Lord is "made present". When we receive Holy Communion we are filled with the real presence of Christ, and are therefore sent to be Christ's presence in the world until he comes again in Glory. The lay ministers who serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) dispense the Blessed Sacrament, the "Bread of Angels" to their fellow parishioners. In addition, EMHC can participate in our Hospital and Homebound ministries to bring the Sacrament to those unable to come to Holy Mass. Extraordinary ministers are fully initiated Catholics, at least 18 years of age, who lead a life in harmony with the undertaking of this ministry including participating in the sacramental life of the Church. New EMHC begin each Fall after Stewardship Sunday in August. After mandatory training in practicum and the Theology of the Most Holy Eucharist the new ministers are commissioned by the Archdiocese for service in our Parish. 
