Message from Fr. Christian Bui



As I reflected on the scripture this weekend, the real challenge of the parable does not seem to be whether or not we have been good stewards of our resources, but what place in our lives does success have – and what would we do to hang onto it.

Money is not the issue. As Pope Francis said, “Money contributes greatly to many good works for the development of the human race”. But, he notes the real problem is a distorted use of money, attachment and greed. As Jesus cautions today, “Take heed and beware of all covetousness.”

“How many families have we seen destroyed by problems over money: brother against brother; father against sons?,” Pope Francis asked. “When a person is attached to money he destroys himself; he destroys his family.”

Psalm 90 tells us, “Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain wisdom of heart”. “If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.”

The letter to the Colossians reminds us to put less focus on our lives here and to “seek what is above ... not what is on earth.”

“One’s life does not consist of possessions”, Jesus cautions; yet, how easily I can forget that. My own riches, honor, pride and my own need for success can lead me to become too busy to listen to God’s voice in my life each day.

Let us pray:

Loving God, help me to slow down and listen to your voice in my heart today. Let me not be distracted by the greed of riches, honor or pride but simply to open my heart to your word. Let me see those around me as gifts from you in my life. I beg you for the spirit of generosity that allows me to share what I have with those who have less - in my wealth and my time.

PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

Preventing child sexual abuse is the goal of the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Office. "Protecting God's Children" is the program selected by the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston to educate clergy, staff, and volunteers who work with children and youth about child sexual abuse and the ways to create a safe environment for children. The 3-hour live session includes videos and facilitated discussions that focus on the prevention of abuse and the protection of children. Adults learn how to recognize the warning signs of sexual abuse and to respond appropriately. You will learn about steps that the faith community can take to create a safe environment for all God's children and how to respond when adults behave in a way that raises concerns.

A "Protecting God's Children" workshop will be held at St. Edward Parish on August 13, 2016 from 9:00am-12:00 noon in the Parish Life Center.

You must arrive at least 30 minutes early and pre-register for this workshop online. We do not allow late admittance or walk-ins. You will need to re-schedule if you arrive late or do not pre-register online for this workshop.

There is no babysitting. No minor child, toddler or infant is permitted in the workshop. There is no exception to this. Do not bring children or youth to the class.

All attendees must have a current Driver's license (any state), State-issued Identification Card, Passport (any country), Mexico or Guatemala Consulate ID in order to attend a "Protecting God's Children" Workshop. When pre-registering for the class, **YOU MUST USE YOUR NAME and DATE OF BIRTH** as it appears on your DL, ID, or Passport. Please pre-register online at www.virtusonline.org.

KEEPING THE PROMISE ALIVE

"Keeping the Promise Alive" is a mandatory refresher course that went into effect 2011-2012. Employees and volunteers are required to attend "Keeping the Promise Alive" after 5 years of attending the "Protecting God's Children"® program. It is a 1.5 hour session with one video that provides ongoing awareness for the prevention of child sexual abuse. The material covered in "Keeping the Promise Alive" is designed to identify and reinforce the lessons of the original "Protecting God's Children" program by clarifying some of the more challenging aspects of the sessions and strengthening the participants' ability to recognize risky behavior by adults in their environments and take action to intervene in potentially threatening situations.

A "Keeping the Promise Alive" workshop will be held at St. Edward Parish on August 10, 2016 from 7pm-8:30pm in the Parish Life Center.

You must arrive at least 30 minutes early and pre-register for this workshop online. We do not allow late admittance or walk-ins. You will need to re-schedule if you arrive late or do not pre-register online for this workshop.
