HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION

On back to back occurrence of Sunday and Holy Days, there is a precept of Eucharist participation for each day. However, whenever January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, or August 15, the Solemnity of the Assumption, or November 1, the Solemnity of All Saints, falls on a Saturday or on a Monday, the precept to attend Mass is abrogated (NCCB, 11/17/92, Congregation for Bishops, 7/4/92). While the Holy Day obligation is automatically abrogated on these days, the liturgy of the feast is still to be celebrated in every parish and institution at a convenient time in such a way that the dignity of the feast is maintained.

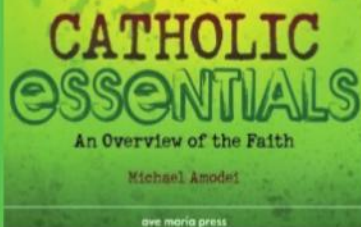
RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

LITURGY CORNER

While it is true we do not have a cry room; we do offer a nursery for children from the ages 1-3 years old in the Parish Life Center and a Children's Liturgy of the Word in the Chapel for the children 4-6 years old. Both of these are available at the 9:30am Mass.

Most of us know how difficult it can be to keep small ones quiet from time to time. Small ones can be difficult when they are forced to be confined for a length of time. We invite you to try out these two services. It may provide you with more peace of mind and allow you to get more from Mass.

BAPTISM PREPARATION

Two sessions are required for both parents and godparents who have not attended a Baptism preparation program in the last three years. There is no cost for the sessions and pre-registration is not necessary. Birth certificate required for issuance of baptism certificate. All questions will be addressed at the sessions.



Session I: The Theology & Ritual of Baptism: 7:00pm-8:15pm in the Parish Life Center the 2nd Monday of each month.

Session II: The Domestic Church: Catholic Family Life: 7:00pm-8:15pm in the Parish Life Center the 4th Monday of the month. It is a **required** follow up session for new parents and godparents, but all parishioners are welcome.

MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT NOAH'S NURSERY

Noah may have only had two of a kind, but Noah's Nursery at St. Edward's Catholic Community welcomes all parish children, ages infant to 4. Noah's Nursery is located in the "old chapel," on the southeast corner of the Parish Life Center. It is available for families during the 9:30 AM Sunday Mass and opens at 9:15 am for drop-off. Parents/guardians must fill out a registration form the first time they bring in their child and future visits only require providing the child's name, date of birth and a parent's cell phone number. Two VIRTUS trained adults are present at all times Noah's Nursery is open and currently the nursery can accommodate 10-12 children. Noah's Nursery would like to expand their ministry to be available during all Sunday Masses, however to do so, more volunteers are needed. If you have a love of children, are VIRTUS trained (or willing to undergo training) and are available to serve in the nursery once every other month, please prayerfully consider joining this ministry. VIRTUS training is required for adults involved with children/youth under the age of 18 in any capacity in the Galveston/Houston Archdiocese. Junior High and High School students are also encouraged to volunteer and are always supervised by VIRTUS trained adults. Youth volunteers can use their hours in the nursery toward their confirmation volunteer hours.
