MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT



RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF CHILDREN (RCIC)

Do you feel called to support, teach & welcome children into the Catholic Church? Children who are un-baptized between the ages of 8-14 have the opportunity to attend RCIC. This is a 2 year process which ends in full initiation to the Catholic Faith. Depending on the age of the child, this includes the following sacraments: Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Eucharist, and Confirmation. The spiritual journey concludes during the Easter Vigil of their second year. RCIC meets on Sundays after the 10:30 Mass in SEEC 22. Parents or Godparents are asked to attend the sessions with the child. Volunteers are always needed to support this beautiful ministry. BAPTISM PREPARATION

Two sessions are required for both parents and godparents who have not attended a Baptism preparation program in the last three years. There is no cost for the sessions and pre-registration is not necessary. Birth certificate required for issuance of baptism certificate. All questions will be addressed at the sessions.



Session I: The Theology & Ritual of Baptism: 7:00pm-8:15pm in the Parish Life Center the 2nd Monday of each month.

Session II: The Domestic Church: Catholic Family Life: 7:00pm-8:15pm in the Parish Life Center the 4th Monday of the month. It is a **required** follow up session for new parents and godparents, but all parishioners are welcome.

LITURGY CORNER

What Occurs at Mass 2: Hearing the Word

The General instruction to the Roman Missal paragraph #29 combines paragraph #21 from the Dogmatic Constitution on Divine revelation *Dei Verbum* with paragraphs 7, 33, 52 of the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy *Sacrosanctum Concilium*.

Putting these 4 paragraphs together, it states: "when Sacred Scriptures are read in the Church, God himself speaks to his people, and Christ, present in his own word, proclaims the Gospel." . . . "Therefore, all must listen with reverence to the readings from God's word, for they make up an element of greatest importance in the Liturgy."

The Gospel of Matthew indicates that wherever 2 or 3 are gathered in his name He will be there also. {Mt. 18:20} The Council of Trent established that the reading of Scripture is the second occurrence of the "real presence" in Mass.

Have you wondered why we close the doors and do not allow entrance into the sanctuary during the readings? It is because there should be no unnecessary movement while we hear the word of God. The readings and the homily are intended to give everyone an opportunity to silently and prayerfully enter into a dialogue with God through the readings. The word can be heard from the Narthex by anyone arriving late; then when everyone stands up and the movement of servers and the deacon begins, people can enter the sanctuary area and find a seat, without breaking anyone's dialogue with the Lord.
