LITURGY CORNER

Prayer in Mass especially Berakah


Berakah is a Hebrew word meaning

blessing. According to the oral law, the Jewish people in Jesus' day were required to utter it 100 times a day.

Today we use Berakah for all but two of the prayers during the Mass. The two prayers that we do not use it in are the Lord's prayer (except for "Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy will be done. On earth as it is in Heaven." which is a Berakah statement) and the universal prayer (often called the prayer of the faithful), which is a prayer of petition.

The Church is teaching us something here it seems. We most likely should attempt to use more Berakah-style prayer in our daily prayers, especially if our prayers are mostly asking for things.

God is prodigal, in that he is constantly pouring out graces upon us. Often we are unaware that we have received these graces until we spend some time in reflection at the end of a day. It can be things such as a day where you escaped a close call on the freeway or you received good news. Sometimes we just take God's grace for granted, but these everyday occurrences are excellent times for a prayer of thanksgiving and praise – a Berakah.


