



Did You Know?

On October 7, 1571, the galleys of the Holy League, under the command of Don John of Austria, squared off against the galleys of the Ottoman Turks in the most important sea battle of all time. Before the battle, the men of the Holy League fell to their knees and prayed the rosarv. In heaven, her Immaculate Heart aflame, the Blessed Mother was listening. Aided by the sudden advantage of a miraculous shift in the wind, the Holy League sunk or captured all but thirteen of the Ottoman's 300 ships. The Christian West was spared the terror of Islamic conquest, and we celebrate the event on October 7 with the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. (Catholic Answers 2016)
