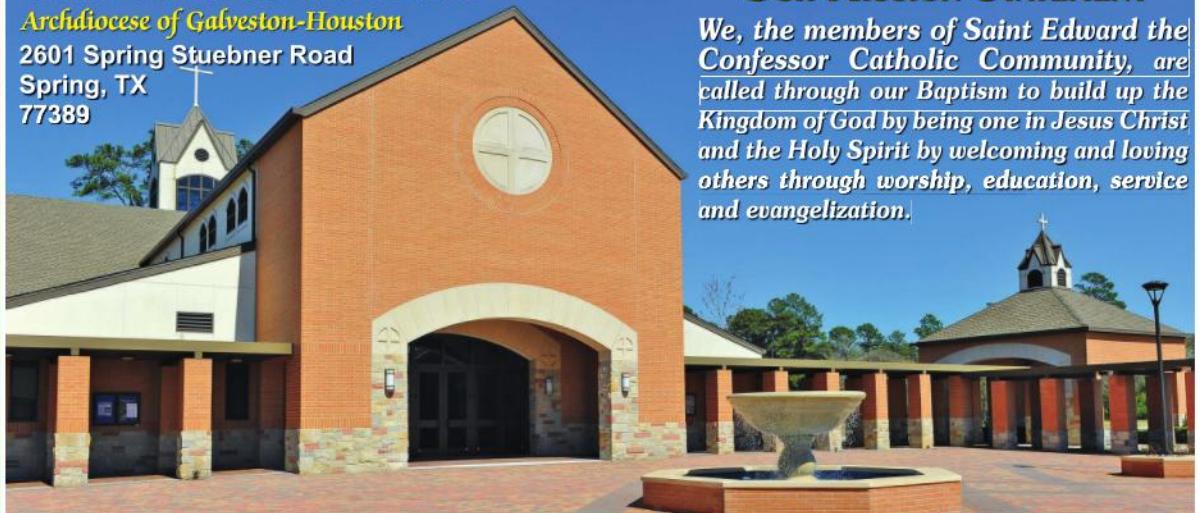

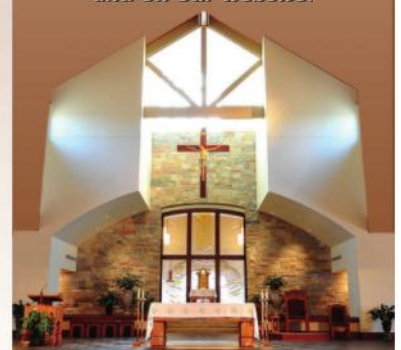

Dear Parishioners,

This week we are given the passage from Matthew 16. 13-20 for our meditation. Last week, through the Canaanite woman, the foreigners expressed “great faith” in Jesus. Now it is the time for the Apostles who have followed Him to acknowledge the identity of Jesus who called them and led them in His mission to the world.

Peter speaks for the disciples and certainly for us, announcing that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of the living God. Jesus confirms this confession by Peter as a mark of God’s blessing and as “rock” upon which he will build his Church (Mt. 16. 15-18).

This story recognizes Peter’s central role as a representative of the disciple community blessed in its confession of faith. Here for the first time, the Gospel of Matthew combined the titles of Messiah and Son of God in acknowledgement of Jesus’ identity.

Names are significant for Matthew. At His birth, Jesus’ name is interpreted as signifying that “He will save his people from their sins”. Now in the same way, the confessor’s name is given significance. Jesus says, his name is Peter, and it is on this rock that he will build His Church. Discipleship is named, founded and commissioned in this confession. Master and disciples are bound together in identity. At the end of the Gospel, Jesus will commission these disciples as representative of a new community to go in His name and make disciples of all nations.

“On this “rock” I will build my Church”. And Church is the new community which Jesus envisaged. Church is the intimate union of the community of disciples and the kingdom of God. Matthew uniquely calls attention to the central mission of this community. This community is entrusted with the promise of a rich gift, the ‘Keys’ of the kingdom: to exercise the power of forgiveness in the binding and loosing of sin in the name of God.

So, as a witnessing community, let us join with Peter and other apostles, and their successors, our Pope and Bishops, to building up of this ‘New Community’ with our time, talents and treasure. Let us make every opportunity to participate in this building process with our abilities and availabilities.
