Message

I would like to share with you the message of Pope Francis to the International Interreligious Peace Meeting in Germany. Pope said: 'May we never forget that peace is not only the fruit of our human efforts, but of openness to God.'

Pope Francis added these efforts "remain timely and necessary as conflicts, violence, terrorism and war increasingly threaten millions of persons, violate the sacredness of human life, and make us all more uncertain and vulnerable."

Concerning the theme "to forge new paths of peace", Pope expressed: "How greatly this is needed, especially where conflicts seem intractable, where the will to undertake processes of reconciliation is lacking, where trust is placed in arms and not in dialogue, thus leaving entire peoples plunged into a dark night of violence, without hope for a dawn of peace."

He exhorts the participants and the people all over the world to "thirst for peace."

Religions are called, alongside political and civil leaders, who are responsible for promoting peace everywhere, by prayer and by humble, concrete and constructive efforts, to respond to this thirst, to identify and, together with all men and women of good will, to pave tirelessly new paths of peace.


Pope Francis reminded, at this present age, religious leaders have a special responsibility "to be and to live as people of peace, bearing insistent witness that God detests war, that war is never holy, and that violence can never be perpetrated or justified in the name of God."

"We are called to trouble consciences, to spread hope, to encourage and support peacemakers everywhere. We cannot and must not remain indifferent, allowing tragedies of hatred to pass unnoticed, and men and women to be cast aside for the sake of power and profit. We must never grow accustomed or indifferent to evil".

'What can be done to respond to such growing evil?' Stand beside each other,' rather than 'some against others' is the only way to deter this growing evil. "Religions cannot desire anything less than peace."

Let us also contribute to the peace efforts of our time. Let us be aware about those who create divisions in society based on cast, color or creed. Be a channel of peace to our humanity.

On September 5, 2017, Cardinal DiNardo, in
his capacity as President of the USCCB, joined
our brother Bishops in the United States in
denouncing the recent decision to cancel the
DACA Program. (Deferred Action for
Childhood Arrivals)

The joint statement issued by the U.S. Bishops
strongly urges Congress to act and immediately
resume work toward a legislative solution.
While we wait Congress' response, there are a
number of **critical deadlines fast approaching**
for youth participating in the DACA Program
corresponding to the expiration of their current
DACA authorizations. The Cabrini Center for
Immigrant Legal Assistance of Catholic
Charities has developed a DACA Renewal
Workshop to assist these young people with
filing DACA Renewal Applications. This
service is provided free of charge. **Please note
that October 5, 2017, is the absolute deadline
for filing renewal applications.**

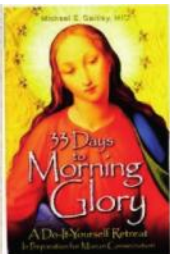
