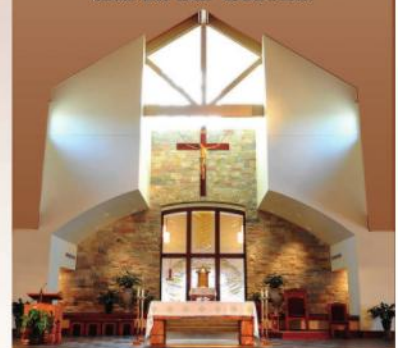

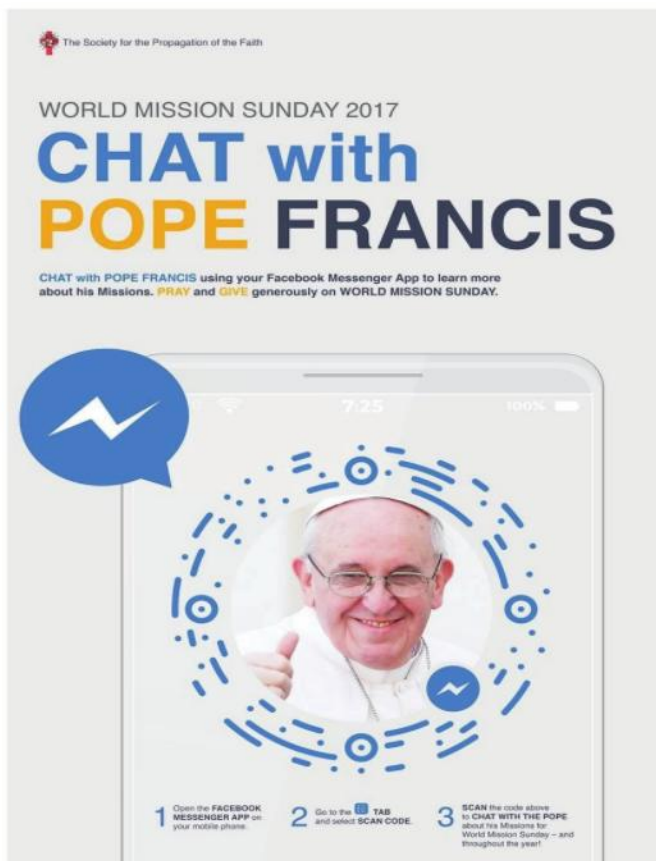
Dear Parishioners;

First of all, let me take this opportunity to thank each and every one who expressed their love and concern for the priests through the prayer cards and kind words of appreciation on Priest's Appreciation Day. Also, I would like to thank our Vocation Committee Team for organizing such a wonderful day. Thank you all for your valuable prayers and support.

In modern society, the word "freedom" is mostly misused or misinterpreted. We are to enjoy freedom to the fullest, whoever we are, and no one can interfere with our freedom. In his encyclical, "Veritatis Splendor", Saint John Paul II reminds us what true freedom means. He taught us that the nature of freedom is oriented to truth; freedom without truth leads to slavery and is not worth having. Values do not diminish from freedom, they invest it. There is no point to liberty without it being freedom to do good.

Freedom doesn't mean, I can do whatever I want. Saint John Paul II continues: "True freedom is not advanced in the permissive society, which confuses freedom with license to do anything whatever and which in the name of freedom proclaims a kind of general amorality. It is a caricature of freedom to claim that people are free to organize their lives with no reference to moral values, and to say that society does not have to ensure the protection and advancement of ethical values. Such an attitude is destructive of freedom and peace."

Therefore, it is necessary from the part of every Christian to recover an awareness of the primacy of moral values in our lives. The great task of today for the renewal of society is that of recapturing the ultimate meaning of life and its fundamental values. So let us join our hands with Jesus and the Church to bring back our value system and dignity of human life.

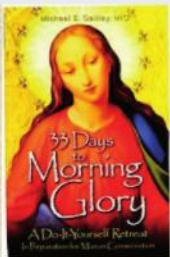

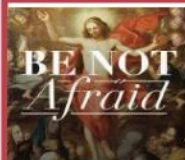
