





SAINT OF THE DAY:

SAINT URSULA, October 21, 383 -Princess and daughter of King Dionotus of Dumnonia in southwest Britain. Postposed her marriage to a pagan king by undertaking a pan-European pilgrimage where she and her group of holy virgins were captured by the Huns. All were tortured and martyred in Cologne, Germany, for refusing to renounce their faith. Christopher Columbus named the Virgin Islands in her honor when sailing past them in 1493. She is the namesake for the Order of Ursulines (founded in 1535) which is devoted to the education of young girls. Patron Saint of the British Virgin Islands, Catholic education (especially of girls), educators, Cologne, Germany, and the University of Paris.


