





Fasting, Full Meal, and Fish Fry

The Knights of Columbus will have a Fish Fry on Ash Wednesday at the PLC! What's on the menu? There will be fish (fried and baked), French fries, onion rings, hush puppies and salad. Proceeds go to school Booster Club and Knights of Columbus council. Since Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent, let's review some Catholic practices. From the USCCB: "Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards."

We ask you to plan your day so that you can eat the "full meal" at the Fish Fry! Remember if you're going to Mass at 7:00pm, then you will have to finish your food before 6pm in order to prepare for Mass.




