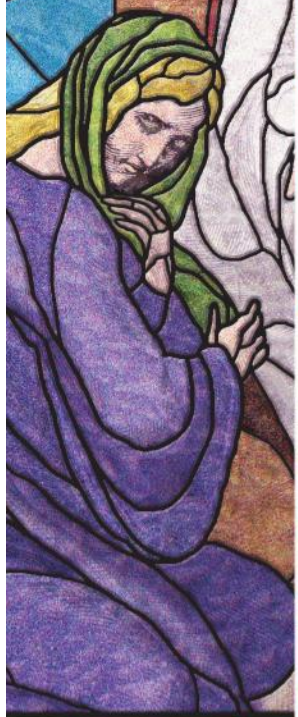

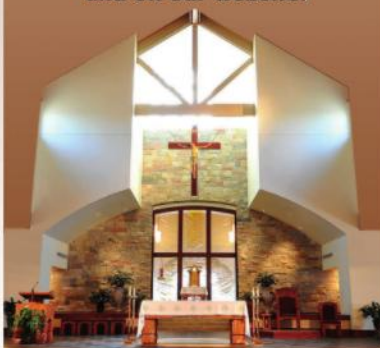

Congratulations to 12 year-old St. Edward parishioner Matthew Reel, son of Gary and Tammy Reel! Matthew was recognized as a "Hometown Hero" by the morning television program "Good Morning America" for his work to help hungry students in the Conroe school district.

Matthew was inspired to begin collecting food for hungry people when he participated in a "blessing bag" project as part of his preparation for First Holy Communion five years ago. That year, he decided that instead of presents for his birthday, he wanted his friends to come and help him put together blessing bags to give to people who are homeless. From there, his non-profit organization, "Matthew's Wish" began to take shape.

Matthew's Wish works with the Conroe school district to identify families who needed food help. They collect food and donations, which are then sent home with children in their backpacks. This past school year, Matthew's Wish committed to sending home packages of food to 25 needy families in the Conroe school district each week. Next year, they want to double that number!

# Exciting changes coming to the 930 AM Mass Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) - PreK to 1st grade

**Beginning August 11th CLOW will now meet  
every 2nd and 4th Sunday- year round!**

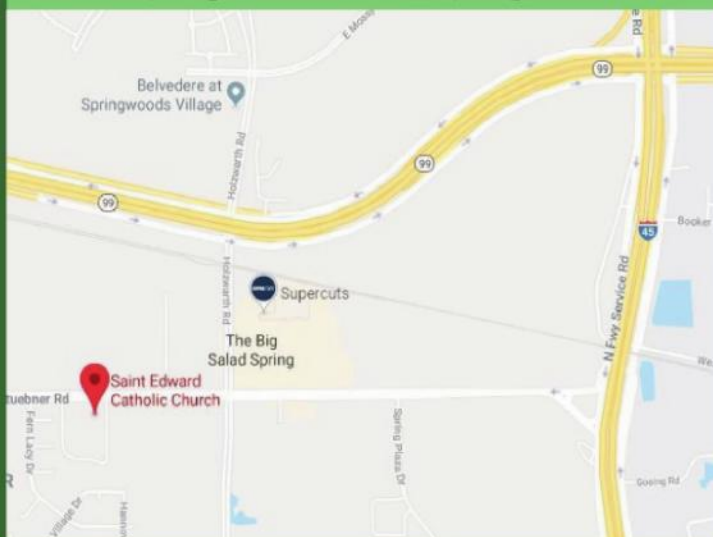
