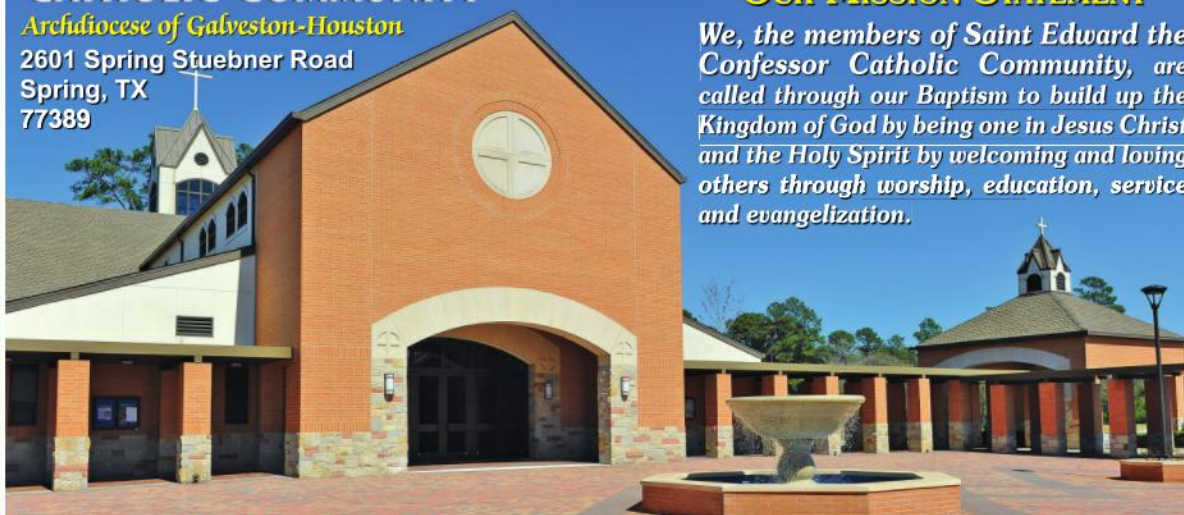

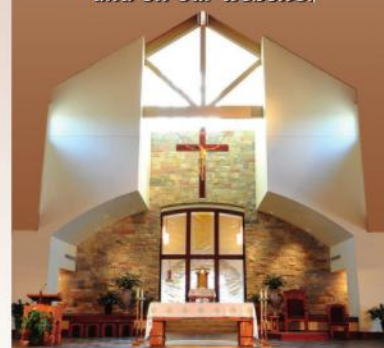

The Saint Edward Catholic Community will be celebrating the 50th anniversary of the founding on October 13, 1969, the Feast of St. Edward the Confessor. There are three main events:

1. The October 13, 2019 11:30 Mass will be the main celebration of the Jubilee, concelebrated by Cardinal DiNardo and Bishop Fiorenza.
2. Fifty hours of Eucharistic Adoration will be held in the chapel to celebrate the Jubilee, beginning on Wednesday, October 9 at 5 pm continuing through two nights to Friday, October 11 at 7 pm.

September 29 - *Worship*; celebrating our priests and deacons, served by Vocation Committee, Altar Society Compassionate Cooks, and Respect Life Ministry

October 6 - *Evangelization*; served by That Man is You, Christ Renews His Parish, Blue Army, Hearts Afire, Prison Ministry
